SET RECIPE – Carrot Cake (C21)

Ingredients for the Cake:

- 150g soft light brown sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 150ml sunflower oil
- 150g plain flour
- 2 teaspoons bicarbonate of soda
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground ginger
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 150g carrots, finely grated
- 50g chopped walnuts

Ingredients for the Cream Cheese Frosting:

- 130g icing sugar, sifted
- 50g unsalted butter, softened
- 125g cream cheese, room temperature
- Juice of ½ lemon
- Extra ground cinnamon and walnuts to decorate

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 170°C (150°C Fan/Gas 3) and line 2 x 19cm round tins.
2. Using a mixer beat the sugar, eggs, and oil together until combined.
3. Add the flour, bicarbonate of soda, baking powder, spices, salt, and vanilla essence to the mix, blending well.
4. Gently fold in the grated carrots and walnuts by hand. Divide mixture equally into the tins. Bake for 20–25 minutes until golden, then let it cool completely.
5. Beat the cream cheese, lemon juice and butter with icing sugar until fluffy, then fill with half the cream cheese frosting and spread the remaining frosting over the cooled cake, finishing with walnuts and cinnamon.

P1 Vet Quiz

TWO members to answer the questions / identify the objects in the Vet Quiz.

P2 Best photo from Rally Day 2026

ONE member to take a photo during the Rally day and send it to yfcadmin Cornwall on messenger by 2pm.

P3 Pallet Recycling

TWO members will be required to dismantle TWO pallets, then make an item of their choice using the majority of the wood. Templates are allowed. Teams to supply their own tools. CHAINSAWS and NAILGUNS ARE NOT ALLOWED. Battery and Rechargeable electric power tools allowed. (No electric on site) Time allowed: 90 minutes maximum time. Pallets to be provided by CFYFC.

P4 Tyre Changing

ONE male and ONE female to change a car tyre. Equipment will be provided.

P5 Sketching

ONE MEMBER will have 15 minutes to sketch a view / item chosen by the judge using pencil only **(Members to provide own paper & pencil)**.

P6 Cramming

The club will be required to fit as many members as possible into an object.

P7 Sheaf Pitching

ONE member will be required to demonstrate their skills.

P8 Tyre Rolling

TWO members to roll their decorated car tyre from class A13 around a course.

P9 Tattoo

ONE member to draw / paint their tattoo design from class A14 onto the arm of ONE other member. (Members to provide art materials).

P10 Banging Nails

ONE male and ONE female to demonstrate their nail banging ability. (Materials will be provided).

P11 Wire a Plug

ONE FEMALE member to wire a seven pin plug. (All equipment, Wire and plug will be provided).

P12 Boiler Suit & Drag Fashion Show

ONE female member to demonstrate their cat walk skills whilst wearing the decorated boiler suit from class A15 AND ONE male member to join the cat walk in their best drag outfit.

P13 Sheep Dog Trials

FIVE members required. ONE member to be dressed as a farmer, ONE as a dog and THREE members dressed as sheep. Sheep and dog to be blind folded then directed on all fours through an obstacle course by means of whistles and commands made only by the farmer.

P14a *Lassoing* (16 & Under)

ONE member to demonstrate their lasso skills

P14b Lassoing (OVER 16)

ONE member to demonstrate their lasso skills

P15 Breed ID

ONE member to identify various different animal breeds.

P16 Panto Cow Obstacle Race

TWO members to dress as a pantomime cow and run around an obstacle course. Costume will be provided.

P17 Soap Race Race

FOUR members to move the clubs soap box from Class H19 around a set course.

THE FOLLOWING RULES MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO, OTHERWISE YOUR CLUB WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE

Soap Box Race

- Helmet and steel toe cap boots must be worn by all.
- No motorised engines allowed.
- Soap Box MUST have functional brakes & be steerable.

Driving

- The route will be timed *All driving to be non-contact.
- Dangerous driving will result in disqualification and the judges' decision is final.

Marks will be awarded for time and also team work!

SPORTS

SP1 *Egg and Spoon Race* - (16's & Under)

ONE member will be required to race with an egg and spoon.

SP2 Six Legged Race

SIX members will be required to run around the main ring tied together chasing the Club in front. Teams caught are eliminated and the race restarts until a winner is found.

SP3 Dizzy Race

FIVE members will be required in relay to circle a post TEN times and then run to the other end of the ring where the next member does as the first.

SP4 Planks Race

SIX members will be required to walk across the ring together on planks.

SP5 Egg and Flour

SIX members will be required to throw and catch alternatively.

SP6

Greasy Pole

ONE MALE member and ONE FEMALE member will be required to knock their opponent off the pole with a pillow (or similar).

SP7 Water Race

FOUR members will be required to move the most amount of water in a set time

SP8 Assault Course Relay

FOUR MEMBERS will be required to complete an assault course in a relay (using the baton from class H17).

SP9 Tug of War (Juniors)

Each team shall consist of EIGHT pulling members aged between 12 years and 17 years on 01/09/2025. At least two of the team MUST be female.

SP10 & SP11 Tug of War (Mens and Ladies)

Each team shall consist of EIGHT pulling members, TWO members of the team may be aged between 15 years and 17 years on 01/09/2025 and the remainder of the team must be aged 18 years or over and 28 years or under on 01/09/2025.

WEIGHT LIMITS for all three classes: Catch All

- All the usual Tug of War rules apply.
- In the event of Clubs joining together, points will be allocated to the club with the majority of members or points will be split if members from different cubs are equal.
- PLEASE NOTE FOOTWEAR TO HAVE A SMOOTH SOLE AND HEAL (NO football boots or trainers)
