Discussion Questions Episode 2: Never Too Far Gone

Take some time to sit with God and pray through what stood out to you the most. Ask Him to show you why that is staying with you and if He has anything to reveal within it.

Do you have a habit of prayer? Is there a desire to create a new habit of prayer? What could you- realistically- be doing now for a stronger prayer life?

Read paragraphs 1854-1864 in the Catechism of the Catholic Church about Mortal sin (you can find the Catechism online as well- a simple search of these paragraphs will have them quickly right in front of you!)

What stood out to you the most?

Are there sins that way you down, or sins that you are afraid to take to confession? How would it feel to bring those to light in the safe place of the seal of confession?

When was the last time you went to confession? What keeps you from going more frequently?
