Severe Weather Policy

As we are getting ready for Spring in Oklahoma I wanted to remind you of our policies. In case of a tornado, please know that we do have a safe place to go within the building. Our teachers have emergency bags that include contact information for all the children, emergency flashlights, first aid kits, and treats and activities to keep the children calm.

In case of emergency, please make sure that you are going to a safe place. Please do not try to get your child at this time. We will not release children when the sirens are sounding. Any parent coming for pickup will be invited to join us in our safe place. After the danger is over, you are welcome to come check on your child and/or take them home. Please be aware that our focus will be on the safety of the children at this time, and if you try to call, we will not be available to answer the phone.
