

INCARNATION & THE SACRAMENTS


- "The Incarnation is the center of all God's plans for mankind."
 - The Incarnation of Jesus has been prolonged from that day until the last day through the sacramental economy that he instituted.
 - Mt. 28:20 "I am with you always, until the end of the age."

SACRAMENTS PREFIGURED IN THE OLD TESTAMENT



- Baptism: Noah's Ark,
 Crossing the Red Sea, etc.
- Reconciliation: Levitical
 Law & Confession of Sins
- Eucharist: Melchizedek, Sacrifice of Passover Lamb.
- Confirmation: Anointing of Kings, Laying on of Hands

- The Sacraments are the principal means of encounter with every man and woman who is incorporated into the Mystical Body of Christ, the Church.
- Form & Matter: God communicates his invisible grace to us by means of visible rites and audible prayers.

BAPTISM


- Forgiveness of Sins & Members of the household of God.

 - Acts 2:38 "Repent and be baptized."
 - 1 Pt. 3:21 "baptism... saves you."





CONFIRMATION

- Deepening of the Sacrament of Baptism. We are empowered and strengthened to live the Christian life.
- Confirmation completes the grace we received in baptism.
- NOT a chance for us to "choose to be Catholic, to make the faith our own."
 - Acts 2 Pentecost
 - Acts 8:14-19



EUCHARIST: RE-PRESENTATION OF THE PASCHAL MYSTERIES
