We invited Pastoral Council and Finance Council to be present as well.

1. Approved for Capital Campaign Committee members to be put in the bulletin – Regina will add that in for the weekend of March 21<sup>st</sup>
2. Approved to have Regina but a section in the bulletin for FWD in Faith updates as far as what projects were completed, by who and the cost. Status of certain projects.
3. Discussed the exterior of church – roof and windows were updated when Fr. Joe was here – so not doing anything with that for FWD in faith
4. Discussed that money raised/pledged for FWD in faith campaign that is not used on projects (left over) will have to be sent up to Springfield, but we are not tithed on that \$
5. Discussed the renderings that were voted on by the three councils (CCC, PC, and FC)
  - a. It was commented on several times during the voting process about having a more neutral option for voting on.
  - b. It was voiced that they were all very similar and didn't have much to vote for other than color behind alter, and trinity option
  - c. The 3 councils are proposing that we consider having three options for the parish to vote on. Here is what we are proposing for parish votes
    - i. They will rank the trinity options in order of 1-3 (favorite to least favorite)
      1. Full trinity (with the 2 angels on the sides and little angels underneath)- Option C
      2. Trinity without any angels (Option D)
      3. Trinity with just the 2 angels on the sides
    - ii. Vote for whether they want to keep the crucifix in the middle of high alter or if they want St. Aloysius in the middle there
    - iii. Vote for the color scheme (all options will not have any murals or pillars on the side arches) (the middle arch will be wider to surround the high alter and the side arches will be lowered.) (rank them again 1-3)

1. Blue ceiling with maroon in all the arches
  2. Blue ceiling with marron in middle arch/ gold on the side arches
  3. Neutral color tan/gold (No blue) ceiling with gold in all the arches (no red behind the main altar.)

6. Approved that the two front pews on both sides at St. Aloysius church will be cut down shorter (18 inches) to allow more room in the front for casket during funeral masses
  7. Discussed new padding for kneelers. Getting bid from Atwood Hamlin Manufacturing. This is who St. Franics in T-Town used for their kneelers.
  8. Discussion was had about either refinishing the pew or just getting all new pews.
  9. Discussed the Grove cemetery road. We have quote to upgrade the drainage and for a concrete road from JB Eskers.
  10. Reiterated that half (\$600,000) of the \$1.2M goal needs to be pledged before any projects can be started.
  11. Beth coordinating with Regina a date in father's calendar for all three councils and father to meet within the next week to approve these minutes
