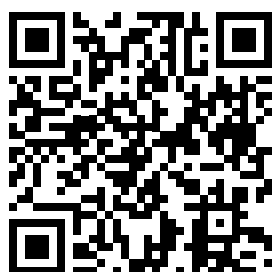

2. Five potatoes other than white
3. Six shallots
4. Three carrots ~ trimmed
5. Three beetroot ~ trimmed
6. Six French beans
7. Six runner beans
8. The LONGEST runner bean
9. Three onions ~ same variety
10. Three courgettes ~ 4-6" (10-15cm) in length
11. Five tomatoes ~ with calyx
12. Seven cherry tomatoes ~ with calyx
13. A vase of four named varieties of herbs
14. Two vegetables ~ same variety, not in schedule
15. Any weird or misshapen vegetable ~ with caption
16. Three chillies ~ any variety (same or mixed)

RULES & CONDITIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

- Only the steward may re-arrange the position of exhibits, anyone found moving entries will be disqualified
- No preparation should be done inside the exhibit tent (unless wet weather), preparation tables are provided
- No boxes, trugs or containers are allowed on the exhibition tables, except where stated
- No exhibits from previous years may be entered
- Exhibits must be staged between **8.30am and 10.30am** on the day of the show
- Exhibitors should vacate the tents by 10.30am. Judging will commence at 11.00am
- Entries should not be removed before 3pm but may be left for auctioning
- All exhibits to be staged in your own containers. The committee cannot be responsible for loss or damage
- Children should put their age with the exhibit
- The exhibitor must have grown all plants and flowers, with the exception of the floral art classes
- Entries must be on the entry forms provided and need to be received at the Merrie Harriers by no later than 9pm Friday the 17th of July 2026
- It is essential to use a separate entry form for every entrant
- No changes of entries are permitted after the entry deadline
- Only one entry per class per exhibitor is permitted
- In every case the judges decision is final
