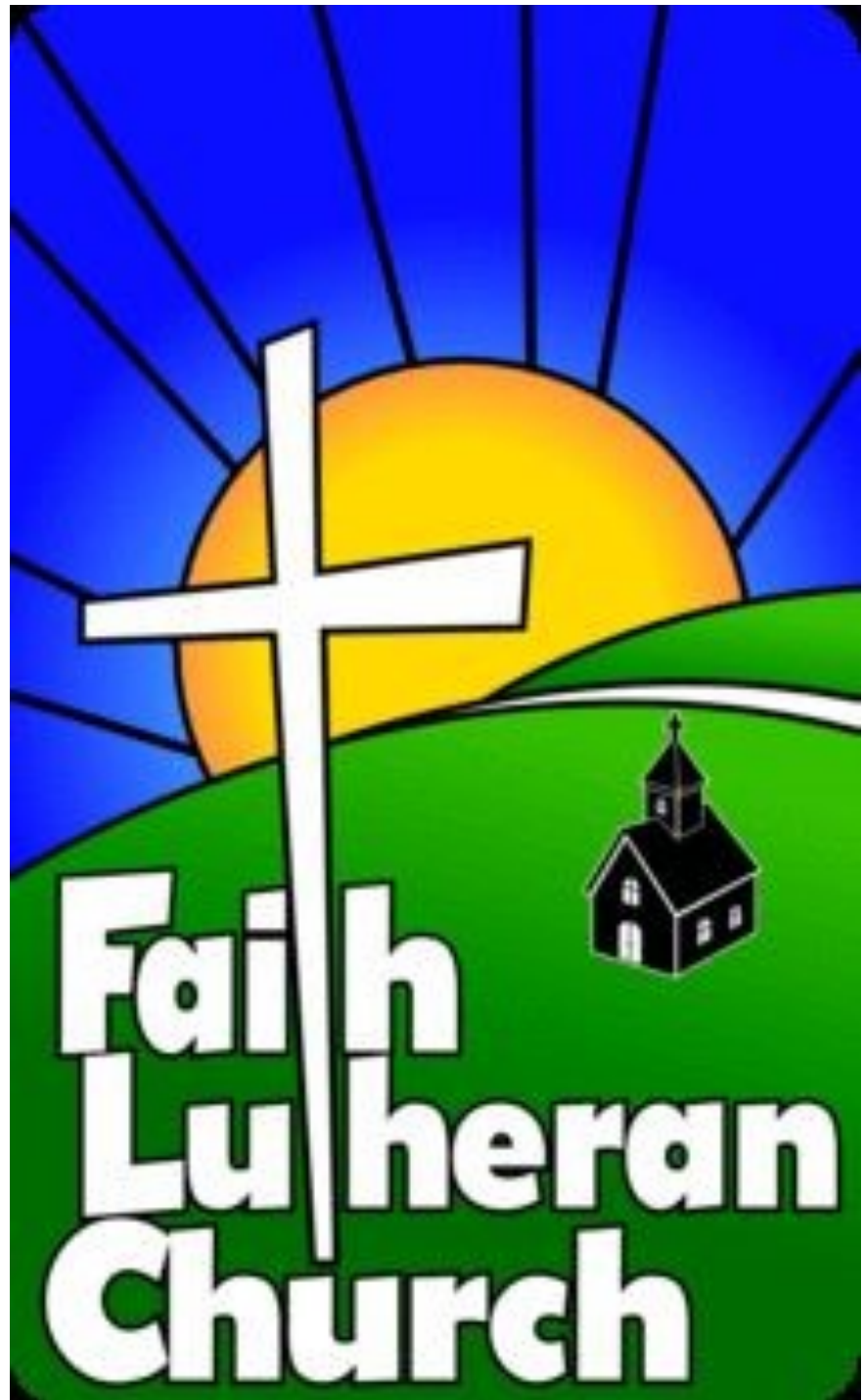

Clippings from the Vinedresser

Grace and Peace to each of you during these 12 days of the Christmas Season.

In Luke [2:8-20](#) we read,

"In that region there were shepherds living in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. Then an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for see — I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign for you: you will find a child wrapped in bands of cloth and lying in a manger." And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host, praising God and saying,

Congregational Budget Meeting Report

I would like to thank everyone who participated in the Congregational Budget Meeting on December 7, 2025. Both the Faith Place and Faith Lutheran Church Budgets were passed unanimously. Please be aware that the Church budget is a Deficit budget, so we all need to dig a little deeper to meet our financial requirements.

At the meeting, Vickie brought up that we need to do some fundraising in 2026 in order to meet our budget needs. This is unfortunate, but has become necessary. Some ideas that came from the meeting are: a yard sale, Christmas Bazaar, both of which we would advertise to the whole community, renewing the auction we used to hold in November. The BIG issue, is we will need members to step up to organize and run these events. Please give prayerful thought as to which events you would like to help with. Please approach any Council member to volunteer to help with any activity, or with any other suggestions you might have. These events need input from EVERY member of the congregation.

Also at the meeting the Congregation passed the amendment to the Constitution stating: "At its annual meeting, the congregation shall elect a Congregational Council of between 7 and 12 members with terms of two (2) years each, with approximately half the terms expiring annually. The members of the Congregational Council must be voting members of the congregation."

This will become official once Synod has given its approval to the change.

We look forward to everyone's continued support in 2026.

Worship Leader Volunteer Opportunities

First of all, thank you to everyone who has volunteered for the various positions and duties that help our congregation run smoothly. We appreciate your gifts of time and talent. We can always use more volunteers, especially in the areas of Counters, Coffee Hosts, Communion Set Up and Clean Up, and Communion Servers. The more people who volunteer, the lighter the load for everyone.

We are especially low on Counters right now. Two people are needed each week, which currently means everyone is counting at least twice a month. The task is simple, opening envelopes received during the service, recording the amounts, and tallying the totals. It usually takes about 15 minutes after the service.

At the request of our insurance company, Counters are now required to have a Level 1 Police Record Check, which is completed online and is a straightforward process. Pastor Pamela has a letter prepared for the “volunteer” rate, and the church will reimburse you for the cost.
