DECISION

BURIAL | CREMATION

While burial or cremation is an initial decision, each has various options available. Some final form of disposition must be decided upon.

Burial

The body can be buried in the ground, at sea, in a green or eco-friendly manner, or placed in a crypt

Cremation

The ashes can be buried in the ground, at sea, or placed in a crypt, divided among family, spread in a location of significance

REFLECTION

GATHER | COMMEMORATE

Reflecting on the life of the deceased can take many forms. Ceremonies and events can include an informal gathering of family and friends, a formal ceremony or recognition in some form that extends over the long term. Ceremonies can be religious or non-religious, and venue choices for these can be as wide ranging as the options for designing them.

Gather

Gathering, visitation, reception of family, friends, and guests for mutual support, sharing memories and condolences

Commemorate

Religious or non-religious service, remembrance, ceremony, and celebration, as part of the healing process

These events can take place privately or publicly, within our facility, at a church, temple, cemetery, or any other place of public accommodation important to the family

The deceased may be present in a casket, urn, photo(s), or video, through music or selected readings, in their connection to a specific location, or via a more formal commemorative ceremony

CARE AND PRESERVATION

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select specific funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a non-ceremonial cremation or burial.

No human remains may remain unburied or uncremated in Pennsylvania for more than 24 hours unless embalmed, encased in a sealed container or refrigerated (49 PA Code §13.201)

REFLECTION

When you choose to have a visitation or ceremony, we will coordinate the arrangements and prepare the facilities appropriately. Our staff will attend and do our best to accommodate any needs.

Please review the options below. Our client families customarily ask us to coordinate a visitation in the afternoon or evening, followed by a funeral ceremony and graveside service the following day.

GATHERING and COMMEMORATION

Family and friends are welcome to gather together at our facility or another location, with or without the deceased present.

Whatever you choose, we will be there to walk with you and assist you in managing the gathering details.

VISITATION

Visitation includes our facilities and staff, or staff and equipment, and can consist of the presence of the deceased in an open or closed casket or an urn or without their physical presence. It is a time for family and friends to gather together to celebrate their life. Either way, we encourage the sharing of photos and memorabilia.

FUNERAL or MEMORIAL SERVICE

Includes our facilities and staff, or staff and equipment, for the service. The deceased is present for a funeral, not for a memorial. At our facility, a church, or other location.

GRAVESIDE SERVICE

Includes our staff and equipment for the service and licensed funeral director accompaniment of the deceased to the cemetery, crypt, or place of scattering.

TRANSPORTATION

All local transfer and transportation fees include locations within 30 miles of our facility. Distance over 30 miles is the local rate plus \$2 per mile one way per vehicle.

CEREMONIAL OPTIONS

Ceremonial options are designed specifically for those who select cremation. They consist of two parts: the shell and the cremation insert. The shell may have been used previously and may be used again. The insert is new each time, as it is cremated efficiently after services. Capella and Aria are full caskets. Chaise Bed is a partial casket with no lid intended for private identification viewings. Selecting one of these options for burial means you understand that the burial will take place in the insert portion only, not the shell.

OUTER BURIAL ENCLOSURES

In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require purchasing a container to surround a casket in a grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container to support the weight of the earth to maintain level, solid ground. Either a burial vault or grave liner will satisfy this requirement.
