Position Overview

The Arena Maintenance Worker will assist with the day-to-day operations, maintenance, and upkeep of the Phil Sharkey Memorial Centre. The position involves physical labor and requires flexibility, as work hours will be scheduled around the ice schedule and arena activities.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform general physical labor, including snow removal and routine arena maintenance.
- Operate and maintain the Zamboni and related equipment (training will be provided).
- Carry out general duties as assigned to support the safe and efficient operation of the arena.
- Maintain a clean, safe, and welcoming environment for all arena users.

Qualifications

- Valid driver's license.
- Reliable transportation to and from the workplace.
- Ability to perform physical work in both indoor and outdoor environments.
- Willingness to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends, based on arena scheduling requirements.

- Previous experience in maintenance, facility operations, or equipment operation is considered an asset but is not required.
