a) Mark Scott, Department of Transportation, and Infrastructure forwarding memo to provide clarification regarding Access permits, Private roads, and public non-maintained roads. The memo notes that access permits are issued by DTI under the Highway Act. Access Permits are required from DTI whenever a person wishes to connect a private road, entrance way, driveway or proposed public road to an existing highway. Private roads are access roads which have been constructed for private use and where the title to the land is not held by the Crown. DTI is not responsible for the administration nor the maintenance or repair to private roads. Public non-maintained roads are a type of public road that is not constructed or maintained to a standard that supports year-round use or activities for commercial industrial or dwelling purposes. DTI has no responsibility to fund the maintenance, repair or upgrade a public non-maintained road.
