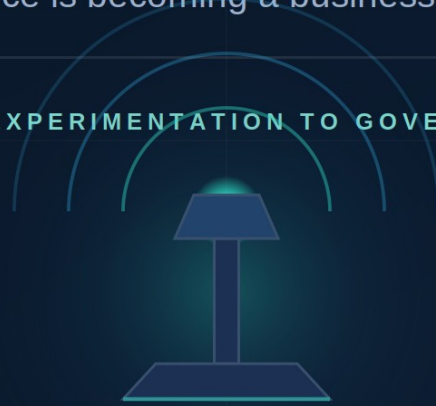

Experimentation

individual, low-stakes use

Enterprise operations

real data, real decisions, real risk

What an AI Review Board Does

A cross-functional group that creates a safe, repeatable path to “yes” — not a path to “no.”



Review use cases

Evaluate purpose, data, benefit, and risk before any tool is deployed.



Classify risk

Internal drafting is not the same as decisions affecting people or money.



Protect sensitive data

Clear rules on what may — and may not — be placed into AI tools.



Review vendors

Where does the data go? Is it used to train the model? What protects us?



Require human oversight

AI should assist people, not replace accountable human judgment.



Maintain an AI inventory

Know where AI is used, by whom, for what — ready for any audit.
