Sermon: God Will Provide Himself

Summary: In movies, an Easter egg is a hidden detail that points to something else. If you look closely enough you can catch these inside references placed there by the writers and directors. We can see similar Easter eggs hidden throughout Scripture that point to the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus. In these weeks leading up to Easter, we'll be hunting through the Old Testament for some Easter Eggs in common stories. This morning our focus is on Abraham and Isaac in Genesis 22.

4 ?s:

- Share an Easter Egg from your own life. What childhood toy, event, etc seems to have more significance when you look at it through today's eyes?
- How does the story from Genesis 22 change if Abraham and Isaac are both participating in offering the sacrifice?
- What can that teach us about the role of both the Father and the Son in Jesus' sacrifice?
- In your life, what meaning does the phrase "God Himself will provide the offering" have?

Application Options:

- Give thanks for Jesus' sacrifice for us. Spend time reflecting on God who both provided a sacrifice and was the loving sacrifice offered in our place.
- Look for ways to cooperate with the Father in offering ourselves for others. This can range from little sacrifices of time or unexpected generosity to larger sacrifices that cost us more dearly as we express the love of God to other people.


