**Day 1:** Board your deluxe motorcoach this morning and travel to Knoxville, TN for our first overnight. Check in at our hotel and enjoy dinner on your own at a nearby restaurant.

**Day 2:** Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before our travel to Chattanooga. Take some time to explore the Chattanooga Choo Choo Hotel Complex. This terminal station in downtown Chattanooga has been converted into a unique hotel and entertainment complex. In the afternoon we visit Rock City Gardens, a true marvel of nature featuring massive rock formations, gardens with over 400 native plant species and a breathtaking "See 7 States" panoramic view. Lunch is on your own at Rock City Gardens.



Check in at the unique, historic Read House Hotel for a 3-night stay. Located in the heart of downtown Chattanooga, this landmark property is within walking distance of top attractions and boasts nearly 200 years of fascinating history, from surviving the Civil War to hosting Elvis. Dinner is on your own and then take some time to enjoy your hotel. **(B)**



**Day 3:** After breakfast we depart for a full day of touring starting with a ride on the Lookout Mountain Incline Railway. The incline is a 4-ft., 8-1/2 inch standard gauge inclined plane funicular railway leading to the top of Lookout Mountain from the historic St. Elmo neighborhood of Chattanooga. You'll be transported to Point Park at the mountain summit, overlooking the city and the Tennessee River. This one mile railway has a maximum grade of 72.7%, making it one of the world's steepest passenger railways.

This afternoon we meet our local guide for a tour of the Chickamauga Battlefield, part of the Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park in Georgia. In 1863, Union and Confederate forces fought for control of Chattanooga, known as the "Gateway to the Deep South." Chickamauga was the site of the bloodiest battle of the Civil War with over 36,000 casualties. The Confederates were victorious but renewed fighting later provided Union troops victory and control of the city. Returning to Chattanooga we'll enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. **(B, D)**



**Day 4:** Today we'll experience a ride on the Blue Ridge Scenic Railway, departing from the charming mountain village of Blue Ridge, GA, and traveling into the lush Chattahoochee National Forest. The relaxing ride starts at the historic depot, built in 1905, then stops for a layover in the quaint sister towns of McCaysville, GA and Copperhill, TN. This is one town with two names because it is split by the GA/TN state line. You'll have time to enjoy lunch on your own, shop for unique crafts and antiques, visit the model railroad layout or walk across the old bridge to view the river before traveling back to the depot.

Returning to Chattanooga dinner is included at a restaurant located in the historic Chattanooga Choo Choo Complex before our evening Trolley Tour. Step aboard and embark on a chilling journey through the enigmatic streets of Chattanooga. "The Legends and Shadows Tour: Unveiling Chattanooga's Dark Secrets" is an unforgettable exploration of the city's folklore and true crime tales. Our expert guide weaves together captivating stories of legends, myths and notorious crimes that have left an indelible mark on the city's history. **(B, D)**

**Day 5:** Following breakfast at the hotel we check out and depart Chattanooga to travel to our last overnight hotel. Dinner is on your own at a nearby restaurant. **(B)**

**Day 6:** Today we continue our journey home, taking with us many fond memories of our Choo Choos of Chattanooga tour. **(B)**
