After services and final disposition of your loved one has been done, you may find there are still a few things that need to be done. Below is a list of some of those things to keep in mind.

 Check on Company Benefits (Employer)
 Call Attorney as Needed

 Make any Changes on Real Estate as Needed
 Make a List for Acknowledgement Cards and Mail
 Plan to Attend Grief/Recovery Workshops
 Mail Death Notices or Personal Cards to Friends Out of the Area Notifying Them of the Death
