



reen Valley and
Sahuarita residents and visitors have a great mix of shopping opportunities to explore.

Green Valley Village in the heart of Green Valley has more than 60 businesses, including boutiques, book stores, restaurants, salons, professional offices, gyms and an Ace Hardware. About a mile away on Continental Road, Continental Shopping Plaza has more than 50 shops and businesses, including a True Value hardware store, restaurants, salons, unique home-grown boutiques selling clothing, gift items and more, and a popular Safeway supermarket.

Major shopping destinations in Sahuarita include the



Sahuarita Plaza on Duval Mine Road, anchored by a Ross Dress For Less, Ace Hardware, Jo-Ann Fabrics, Petco, restaurants and a Dollar Tree at the west end of the plaza. Across the street, The Crossing at Sahuarita at the southeast corner of Nogales Highway and Abrego Drive features a popular Sprouts store, TJ Maxx, PetSmart and Bealls outlet, along with a MOD Pizza restaurant, Starbucks coffee shop, Chipotle Mexican Grill, Popeye's, Eegees and

To the west of Interstate 19 is the Valley Verde Center with an Ashley Furniture Homestore, Desert Sky Cinema, Planet Fitness, several restaurants and an Arizona Department of Motor Vehicles office that's open weekdays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

more.

Also on Duval Mine Road at La Cañada Drive is the Sahuarita Palms Plaza, anchored by a Safeway supermarket and gas station and home to a variety of small shops, businesses and restaurants.

To the east is Madera Marketplace with a Walmart Supercenter, two banks,

automotive shops, Walgreens, restaurants and more. South on Abrego at Esperanza **Boulevard** is a Tractor Supply Co. store, featuring tractor/ trailer parts and accessories along with lawn/garden, home maintenance and pet supplies.

Fry's Marketplace and Chase Bank anchor the Rancho Sahuarita Marketplace and Village at Interstate 19 and Sahuarita Road, along with a dry cleaners, dentist, veterinary and medical offices, salons and restaurants. And just to the east, The Corner at Rancho Sahuarita hosts a Panda Express, Arby's and Fry's gas station and new businesses. Nearby, the Sahuarita Library has been welcoming the public since September 2021.

In addition, unique shopping and dining experiences in Green Valley and Sahuarita can also be found at The Marketplace on Calle de las Tiendas; The Quorum Plaza on West Beta Street, home to Copper Fitness and more; the White Elephant thrift store off La Cañada Drive; and Madera Plaza at the corner of Continental Road and Whitehouse Canyon Road.

#### MORE COMMERCE

The Sahuarita Advanced Manufacturing and **Technology Center,** a hub for business innovation research and technology, welcomed PowerPhotonic to the town's 32,000-square-foot multi-tenant advanced manufacturing center — the first of its kind in Sahuarita — on the southwest corner of La Cañada Drive and Sahuarita Road. A Scottish company that uses laser micro-machining to manufacture micro-optics products, PowerPhotonic moved into SAMTEC in March 2022. Also moving into SAMTEC will be Global Water Resources, serving part of the area's water needs.



## **GOVERNMENT SERVICES**

#### **GREEN VALLEY**

ecause Green Valley is an unincorporated community, the majority of its municipal services are provided by Pima County. Most local, county and state services can be found at the Pima **County Government complex** at 601 N. La Cañada Drive in Green Valley.

The complex houses Precinct 7 of the Pima County Justice Court, which handles local traffic, criminal and civil violations and issues marriage certificates. The Justice of the Peace can perform marriage ceremonies at the court as well. There's also a representative of the District 4 supervisor's office.

The Pima County Sheriff's Department Green Valley substation can also be found at the complex. The PCSD deploys squads of deputies and supervising sergeants. Staffed by a public safety support specialist and members of the Green Valley Sheriff's Auxiliary Volunteers, the substation is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The popular Joyner-Green Valley Branch Library also is at the complex, offering a large selection of books for adults, teens and children, as well as a poetry group and a book club.

All other government services are in Tucson.

## **GOVERNMENT SERVICES**

#### **SAHUARITA**

ncorporated as a municipality in 1994, the town of Sahuarita has a council-manager form of government. The Town Council typically meets every second and fourth Monday.

Most town employees are on a four-day, M-TH work week. Sahuarita has its own police force, a municipal court and a town attorney and prosecutor. Its Parks and Recreation Department oversees leisure activities in the town. The Public Works Department watches over the town's streets, wastewater and engineering needs. The Planning and Building Department issues building permits, performs fire inspections, and maintains standards for building safety. Fire service is provided by Santa Rita Fire District, formerly Green Valley Fire District.

In addition to the current selection of 489 Independent Living apartments, Garden Home townhouses, and freestanding homes up to 2,315 square feet of living space.

If ever needed, innovative and engaging supportive living and memory care neighborhoods are available on site to La Posada community residents. In La Posada Independent Living, there are up to five RN Navigators situated for support and guidance through the Posada Life Wellness team. There are four wonderful dining venues, with a cooked-to-order family feel, that serve as primary social gathering spots.

The La Posada campus is a 130-acre gem, beautifully landscaped and developed over time. There is an open



feel here, with opportunities for long walks along the Santa Cruz River path, rolling around the campus on a fleet of shared bicycles, or a quick ride on one of the La Posada trams.

As a non-profit led by a local board of trustees, La Posada makes a strong commitment to giving back. La Posada **Community Services offers** programs including a senior lunch program, daytrips, adult day services, and counseling. Next door to the Community Center, Los Niños del Valle offers an innovative and engaging pre-school for kids from 12 months to 5 years and beyond. Many La Posada residents express their kindness and generosity through volunteerism, both in the greater Green Valley / Sahuarita community, and on the La Posada campus. Through the La Posada Foundation, residents support campus improvements, key programs, and a robust La Posada Scholarship program. In a typical year, up to \$150,000 in scholarship awards help to



further learning of all types by individual La Posada employees.

The Shoppes at La Posada, situated where the campus meets Continental Road, offers tasty coffee and treats at Posada Java, and is a popular gathering place for free music and art events. For wonderful consignment finds, the Vensel Treasure Shoppe offers high-quality, gently used furniture and décor. This is another spot where good spirits and kind-

ness abound.

ahuarita Unified School District No. 30 (SUSD) is a premier public school district in Southern Arizona, serving 6,400 students in grades K-12. Founded in 1964, the district is proud of its long tradition of academic excellence. Since then, Sahuarita Unified School District has become known for its innovative curriculum,

rich history and sense of community. Today, the district is made up of a childcare/ early education center, two high schools, one K-2 primary



school, one 3-5 intermediate school, one middle school, two K-8 schools, two K-5 elementary schools and one K-12 online school.

Both award-winning high schools offer a wide selection of educational choices in academics, the arts, sports and career and technical education. Our graduates continue to be admitted to a wide number of universities, and among the nation's best

schools. This past year, our graduates earned more than \$13.1 million in scholarships! Through our 30 dual college enrollment programs with Pima Community College, our high school students can earn college credits while simultaneously earning high school credits. The college tuition value of these earned credits at the local state universities is about \$3 million.

In athletics, the Walden Grove High School girls soccer team brought home a state championship and its academic decathlon team qualified for nationals. Sahuarita High School's boys wrestling team secured its third consecutive state championship.

The NJROTC Raiders ranked eighth in the nation and SUSD's Career and Technical Education (CTE) students qualified for state competitions.

- New football fields and tracks were installed at Walden Grove and Sahuarita high schools thanks to a \$50 million bond passed by voters in 2023.
- The bond also will provide for a new auditorium at Walden Grove High School that will ease demand at the district auditorium.
- Wrightson Ridge School will see seven new classrooms, including a new art room and a new room to grow Career and Technical Education programs.
- New safety measures are also being put into place in the district, including new hightech cameras and riot-proof and bullet-resistant laminate windows. As the 2023-2024 school year unfolds, there are new and promising next steps and indicators of further



progress and success in the Sahuarita Unified School District.

n Sahuarita, Northwest Healthcare has served the Green Valley and Sahuarita communities for more than 10 years, and in 2020 Northwest Medical Center Sahuarita opened as a full-service neighborhood hospital to further solidify their commitment to the community.

Northwest Medical Center Sahuarita has 18 medical/ surgical inpatient beds to take care of patients after surgery, or with illnesses that require hospitalization. Emergency care is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. There are two operating rooms, currently offering orthopedic surgery, general surgery, podiatric surgery, spine surgery, gastroenterology procedures,

and pain management procedures.

The hospital also offers outpatient procedures including routine lab work and diagnostic imaging (x-ray, ultrasound, CT scans, Nuclear Medicine, stress testing and more).

In addition to the hospital, Northwest Healthcare also operates Northwest Primary & Specialty Care, employing 14 providers in Sahuarita and Green Valley. Specialties include Cardiology, Family Medicine, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Internal Medicine, Orthopedic Surgery, Pain Management, Podiatry, Spine Surgery, and Urogynecology.

In Southern Green Valley. the Health & Wellness Campus at 4455 S. I-19 Frontage Road is home to Valley Ear, Nose & Throat; United Community Health Center (UCHC); AZ Kidney Disease & Hypertension Center; Pima Pain Center; and DMC Dermatology.

In addition to its Frontage Road location, UCHC serves patients at its Sahuarita offices at 1260 S. Campbell Road: 670 S. Park Centre Ave.; Sahuarita Heights Clinic on Sahuarita Road, as well as its Amado Clinic.

Haven Health bought Santa Rita Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. Arroyo Gardens is an assisted living community offering 86 apartments, and outpatient physical therapy. Other providers in town include Silver Springs assisted

## GREEN VALLEY COUNCIL

reen Valley was developed as a standalone or full-service community for retired persons in 1964, complete with medical facilities, places of worship, essential shopping, restaurant and business services, and exceptional recreational opportunities. Green Valley is in Pima County, adjacent to the Santa Cruz River Valley in Southern Arizona. It is approximately equally distanced south of Tucson, Arizona, and north of Nogales, Sonora. Green Valley aligns with the Santa Cruz River Valley and is bounded by the copper mines to the west and the Union Pacific Railroad to the east. Safety. law enforcement, and judicial services are provided by the Pima County Governmental sub-complex in Green Valley. Fire protection services are provided by the Santa Rita Fire District.

The town of Green Valley lies in unincorporated Pima County, On June 23, 1973, the Green Valley Council Inc., a 501(c)(4) nonprofit, was created to serve as an all-volunteer representative organization for the original Green Valley Homeowners Associations. In



the 51 years since then, the Green Valley Council has grown to be the recognized and unified civic voice of Green Valley.

The Green Valley Council represents the Green Valley community at the local, county, state, federal, and tribal governmental levels. The GVC operates through its eight standing committees that interface directly with their counterparts in Pima County. These include Traffic & Arroyos, Health and Human Services, Planning & Architecture, Environmental,

Parks Advisory, Community Services, HOA Relations, and Citizens Corps Emergency Response. Strategic direction comes directly from the Green Valley community.

Incorporated as a membership organization, the residents of Green Valley become members through the 800-plus member HOAs, HOA affiliates, businesses, and public service organizations. Each member has a seat on the Board of Representatives, the Council's governing body. More than 200 people volunteer hundreds of hours of their time and talent each year to serve on the Council and its Committees to ensure that Green Valley remains a premier place to live, work, play, and invest. All Council and Committee meetings are open to the public.

The Council sponsors programs such as the Preferred Vendor Program; Dispute Resolution; Community Forums; Homeowner Association (HOA) workshops; Legal Workshops; Planning and Architectural Permit review; Service Line Warranty; Service Requests for people to report problems with county-owned roads and other property; and contractual support for Pima County.

In 2012, the Council created The GVC Foundation Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit affiliate, to help support special projects that offer new services or

# az 19 santa cruz valley attractions

Come explore Az19, a storied locale rich with educational, recreational and multi-cultural opportunities. Visit a historic mission, a mineral shop, missile site and quiet, natural beauty highlighted by the scenic Santa Rita Mountains.

he spiritual and historic Mission San Xavier del Bac, between Tucson and Sahuarita, dates to the late 1700s. Known as the White Dove of the Desert, it is an architecturally significant historic landmark off Interstate 19 on the Tohono O'odham Nation. Visitors can view the ornate parish church from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., and the gift shop is open daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Mass times are Saturdays at 5 p.m. and Sundays at 10 a.m and noon. Museum visits and guided tours are available.

Heading south, the Asarco **Mineral Discovery Center** in Sahuarita provides visitors an opportunity to learn about the importance of mining in everyday life. It includes an award-winning exhibit center, video theater, cactus garden and picnic area. Visitors also can stand at the edge of an open-pit copper mine, and stop at the mill to see how the ore is processed. Shop at the Company Store gift shop, too.

Wanna bet — or be entertained? The Desert Diamond Casino on Pima Mine Road features slot machines, table games from Blackjack to Roulette, and Keno, plus entertainment and dining choices that include Taste of Agave — At The Buffet, the Diamond Grill, and the Sportsbook & Bar.

Also in Sahuarita, the **Titan** Missile Museum offers tours that take visitors 30 feet underground to see the silo of this former intercontinental ballistic missile site, now a National Historic Landmark. The only ICBM site in the world with a Titan II missile in the launch silo, this complex provides above-ground and underground exhibits depicting the Cold War era. See the command center and walk the silo cable ways.

At Historic Hacienda de la Canoa at the Raul M. Grijalva Canoa Ranch Conservation Park in southern Green Valley, Pima County Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation staff and volunteers offer a variety of intriguing guided tours of the ranch buildings, gardens and corral, birding tours at the lake, plus special nature and history-oriented events for the public. Dating back to the original Spanish San Ignacio de la Canoa land grant, this ranch was a stop for the Anza Expedition in 1775-76 and was one of the largest cattle ranches in Arizona when operated by the Manning family from the early 1900s until the 1970s.

Farther south is Tubac

Presidio State Historic Park and Tumacácori National Historical Park with a historic adobe church.

# TUBAC

bout 20 miles south of Green Valley on Interstate 19 is a quaint little riverside village that calls itself the place where art and history meet.

Indeed, the village of Tubac has dozens of shops, galleries and restaurants, many of them selling unique products made by the artists and artisans who call the village home.

Tubac's history is impressive as well. It was here, in 1752, that the first European settlement in what is now Arizona was founded when the Spanish built a presidio near the banks of the Santa



Cruz River. The area's history is celebrated at Tubac Presidio State Historic Park, where, every fall, the town turns out to recognize local hero Juan Bautista de Anza II, a commandant of the presidio, an Indian fighter and colonizer who led a group of settlers

to California in 1775-1776 to establish what is now San Francisco.

Tubac has established itself as a resort destination with the expansion and renovation of the Tubac Golf Resort, and a place for high-end vacation and part-time homes.

# TUMACÁCORI




ust down the road from Tubac is Tumacácori, where a Spanish mission still stands at Tumacácori National Historical Park as a reminder of the part this region once played in settling the New World. Across the street is the Santa Cruz Chili & Spice Company, offering an enticing selection of chili spices and seasonings along with southwestern cookbooks, local history and kitchen essentials.

rivaca is a beautiful rural community 23 miles off Interstate 19 south of Green Valley. The gentle winding road to Arivaca is the perfect afternoon drive.

Just be careful as you travel down this road. Be on the lookout for rabbits, covotes, deer and open-range cattle. Once you arrive in Arivaca, there are a number of things to see and do.

Arivaca's town site was originally a Pima Indian village. Mining operations in the area began in 1856, and when the mines played out, ranching took over.

Today, it's the home of the Arivaca Cienega, a wetland



associated with the Buenos Aires National Wildlife Refuge. There are hiking trails and interpretive signs telling about the area and the wildlife you may encounter. # AMBOS NOGALES

he government seat of Santa Cruz County is Nogales, Ariz., home to about 20,000 residents. Its sprawling Mexican namesake just to the south in Sonora has about 20 times that number.

The U.S. city is a government center with retail outlets, restaurants, and a sizable warehousing center for fresh produce coming across the border.

In Mexico, the city of Nogales is a modern factory and produce shipping center, but it's also a tourist destination. It's easy to get there. Just walk across the international border in downtown Nogales, Ariz. The tourist area immediately south

of the border has restaurants. shops and, if you want, pharmacies and dentist offices. You can drive into Mexico, but the lines of cars driving north into the United States can be long and move slowly.

There's a U.S. Consulate in south Nogales, Sonora, on Calle San Jose, about five miles south of the border. It's open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, closed on weekends and on U.S. and Mexican holidays. Its Mexican phone number is 01-631-311-8150 or 01-631-313-4797. From the United States the number is 011-52-631-313-48-20.

Although it's hassle-free to enter Mexico, U.S. citizens need a passport or passport card to

# SANTA RITA MOUNTAINS & MADERA CANYON

mong the highlights in the Santa Cruz Valley for visitors and residents alike is Madera Canyon in the Santa Rita Mountains east of Green Valley, Called a Sky Island, the wooded canyon is only 11 miles southeast of Green Valley, but it sports an environment quite different from the desert below.

Madera Canyon is a haven for flora and fauna found nowhere else in the United States, and it has three distinctive lodges, miles of trails ranging from easy to very difficult, and picnic facilities.

According to the Friends of Madera Canyon, a Green Valley-based advocacy group charged with protecting the canyon, more than 200 bird species have been seen in the canyon, including rare ones like the elegant trogan, flamecolored tanager, red-faced warbler and the rose-breasted grosbeak.

The best trails in Madera Canyon climb the southern side of Mount Wrightson, including the Old Baldy Trail and the Super Trail, both of which lead to the 9,456-foot

Madera Canyon. Visitors will find mesquite trees, several varieties of evergreen oaks, alligator junipers, Arizona madrones, cottonwoods, whitelimbed sycamores, ponderosa pines and more.







# ANZA TRAIL

he Anza Trail has many segments that run from Culiacan, Mexico, to San Francisco, Calif., following as closely as possible the historic route taken by Juan Bautista de Anza II and 240 immigrants in the winter of 1775-76.

In this region of Southern Arizona, hikers, bicyclists and equestrians can use:

• A 5.2-mile section in the Canoa Ranch area, just south of Green Valley, that begins east of Interstate 19 on Elephant Head Road near the Santa Cruz River. The trail here is a packed surface for foot and bicycle traffic. Equestrians can use the river wash so as not to damage the trail.

• Take the Abrego Trailhead in Green Valley along Abrego

on the east side of Abrego Drive. covering three miles. Hike south from here to the Elephant Head Road Trailhead. Hikers also can head north from the Abrego Trailhead to the north end of the Country Club of Green Valley golf course, and continue to the Llano Grande trailhead in the town of Sahuarita, From there, the trail follows close to the Santa Cruz riverbed up to the southern boundary of the San Xavier Indian Reservation.

• A rather lush, 3.8-mile section follows the river from the presidio at Tubac to the mission at Tumacácori. This is one of the more popular hikes in the Santa Cruz Valley and can be picked up at well-marked trailheads at the mission and

the presidio. It's a beautiful route and this mostly flat, easy trail is a great option for families. The trail also extends north from Tubac for about a mile. This is a top trail section for birders.

• A 5.5-mile stretch of the trail near Rio Rico follows the river and winds through mesquite forests. Take I-19 exit 17, Rio Rico/Yavapai Drive. Park at the trailhead next to the Santa Cruz County building and look for the trailhead sign.



# Soak up the beauty, culture and history of Southern Arizona

**CULTURE & COMMUNITY** 

estled in the southwestern corner of the United States, Southern Arizona is a captivating destination that boasts a rich cultural heritage, breathtaking landscapes and a thriving wildlife. Known for its stunningly colorful sunsets, rugged landscape and regal saguaro cactus, the beauty of Southern Arizona is a must-see experience.

Southern Arizona is a treasure trove of history and culture, with numerous attractions that showcase the region's diverse heritage. The Santa Cruz Valley was designated a National Heritage Area in 2019 by Congress as it is one of the longest inhabited regions in America, over 4,000 years. The Coronado National Forest encompasses majestic mountain ranges, offering opportunities for outdoor activities like hiking, camping and birdwatching. For those seeking a touch of enchantment, the otherworldly landscapes of the Chiricahua National Monument, with its towering rock formations, provide a unique and unforgettable experience.

Southern Arizona is renowned for its delectable cuisine, blending American, Mexican and Native American flavors. The city of Tucson has gained recognition as a UNESCO Creative City of Gastronomy, offering a vibrant food scene with a variety of dining options, from classic Mexican dishes to innovative culinary creations.

Tubac, established in 1752, is a delightful artists' community with a fascinating history. Visit the Presidio, Arizona's first state park, and learn about the long trek of Juan Baustista de Anza as he traversed the southwest on his way to northern California. Perhaps you will recognize the famous arches at the entrance of Tubac Golf Resort and Spa where the movie "Tin Cup" was filmed.

Adventure seekers will find Southern Arizona to be a paradise for outdoor activities. The



region's mild climate allows for year-round exploration, whether it's hiking through picturesque canyons in the Santa Catalina Mountains, horseback riding in the vast open spaces or biking along scenic trails like the Tucson Loop. Water enthusiasts can kayak or paddleboard in the serene waters of Patagonia Lake State Park or go river rafting in the thrilling rapids of the Salt River.

#### A BIRDER'S **PARADISE**

With its year-round mild climate and diverse ecosystems, Southern Arizona offers an unforgettable birding experience. Whether you explore the canyons, riparian areas or desert habitats, you'll have the opportunity to encounter an incredible variety of avian species in this captivating region.

Madera Canyon is a world-renowned birder's paradise. With its shaded canyons, streams and waterfalls, it is home to many species of birds. Watch the jeweled hummingbirds flit about as they feed. Look into the trees and you may spy the elegant trogon or perhaps a scarlet tanager taking a rest among the branches.

The San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area is another must-visit for bird enthusiasts. This riparian habitat along the San Pedro River attracts a variety of migratory

and resident birds, including the rare southwestern willow flycatcher and the vibrant vermilion flycatcher.

#### **UNVEILING THE DARK** SKIES OF SOUTHERN ARIZONA: A STARGAZER'S **PARADISE**

Nestled amidst the rugged beauty of the Sonoran Desert lies Southern Arizona, a celestial haven that beckons astronomers and stargazers from around the world. With its dark skies and high-altitude locations, this region is a treasure trove of celestial wonders and a haven for cutting-edge research. From renowned observatories to state-of-the-art research labs, Southern Arizona offers an unparalleled opportunity to explore the mysteries of the cosmos.

Five major observatories are all within a couple of hours drive from Green Valley/ Sahuarita. These observatories are Kitt Peak National Observatory, Fred Whipple, a Smithsonian Institution, Mt. Graham International Observatory, the Mt. Lemmon Sky Center operated by the University of Arizona and observatories at the University of Arizona campus.

Located on the campus of the U of A, the Flandrau Planetarium is a fun, interactive and informative exploration of the mysteries of the universe.

#### THE WILD WEST REVISITED

One would be remiss to not mention Arizona's Western heritage. Many familiar names of the Wild West had roots in Arizona. Wyatt Earp, Johnny Ringo, Pancho Villa and Doc Holliday are a few names associated with Arizona's wild past.

Visit the Historic Canoa Ranch and see one of the original Spanish land grants. The original ranch buildings have been restored, as have the lake, where visitors can see what life in the 1880s and early 1900s was like.

Tombstone should be on everyone's list as a must see for those who love the stories of

the West. Walk its dirt streets and visit the O.K. Corral where the Earps and McLaurys' historic gunfight took place. Check out the Bird Cage Theater for an authentic feel for what early Tombstone was like. Visit the AZ Rangers' Museum to learn the history of the men who helped to bring law and order to the Arizona Territory.

Southern Arizona was, and still is, a favorite of Hollywood. Old Tucson, Mescal Movie Set and the Empire Ranch have all hosted such names as Clint Eastwood, James Garner, Tom Selleck and the Duke, John Wayne. Ranch. Enjoy these historic sets as you follow in their boot prints — cowboy boots, of course.
