- Entries should try to keep with the spirit of the parade! Please keep entries and statements friendly and positive.
- <u>Items may be handed out</u>, but <u>NOT thrown</u> to the public along the parade route (paper hand-outs, candy etc.)
- Dignitary & Campaigning Dignitary entries & business are charged an entry fee of \$15.00. Checks are written out to WCOSA
- There is no fee for regular entries but purchasing a ribbon at the registration booth in Pioneer Park will help support our 100% volunteer organization and will be appreciated. Donations are also gladly accepted.
- After reaching the end of the parade, you can let people off the floats (see map).
