ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The admission requirements for a Bachelor of Hospitality Management in Ghana:

WASSCE/SSSCE applicants

- WASSCE and SSSCE candidates: three credit passes in three core subjects and three credit passes in three elective subjects.
- General Certificate of Education (GCE) Advanced Level candidates: three credits in three subjects, with an overall aggregate of 24 for best six subjects.
- Diploma holders: a pass in a relevant diploma program and a minimum of a pass in all courses.

Mature Age Applicants

- Applicants must be at least 25 years at the time of application.
- Applicants must register for, attend, and complete the Access Course and pass the Mature Students' Entrance Examination conducted by the University.

Applicants in possession of university of Ghana diplomas or recognised equivalent diplomas

- Holders of Diplomas or recognised equivalents, with a Final Grade Point Average (FGPA) of 3.00 or better in any of
 the under-listed programmes, are eligible to apply to the SAME area of study and supported with two other subjects
 in a related field, for admission.
- In addition, such applicants MUST have WASSCE/SSSCE passes in three (3) core subjects and two (2) electives in the appropriate subjects OR credit passes in five subjects including English Language and Mathematics at the GCE 'O' Level as well as passes in two subjects at the GCE 'A' Level.

Holders of Higher National Diplomas (HND)

- Holders of Higher National Diplomas (HND) from a recognised Polytechnic with a Final Grade Point Average (FGPA) of 3.25 or better in any of the under-listed programmes, are eligible to apply to the SAME area of study, and where required, supported with one other subject in a related field, for admission.
- In addition, such applicants MUST have WASSCE/SSSCE passes in three (3) core subjects and two (2) electives in the appropriate subjects or credit passes in five subjects including English Language, Science and Mathematics at the GCE 'O' Level as well as passes in two subjects at the GCE 'A' Level.

Diploma Programmes

- Six Passes (A-D) in all subjects, including English Language and Mathematics; and
- At least three (3) of the passes must be in subjects in General Arts, Business, or Science.

All admission is governed by the institution's Admissions Policy (RIUC002), which, in line with the principles of all relevant legislation, ensures no discriminatory practice and enables us to promote access to tertiary education.
