**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The following is required to be considered for admission:

- a) Applicants with a master's degree by research or coursework in the major and specific discipline area from an accredited University or college, with a minimum 3.0 CGPA.
- b) Applicants with a master's degree by research or coursework in other business disciplines related to the specific discipline area from an accredited University or college, with a minimum 3.0 CGPA.
- c) Applicants with master's degree by research or coursework in a non-business discipline, from an accredited University or college with a minimum 3.0 CGPA, in addition to a professional qualification in the specific discipline area, will be considered for admission on a case-by-case basis.
  - A minimum of two to three years of working experience.
  - Fluency in spoken and written English.
  - Submit a curriculum vitae, two referee reports and personal motivations.

All admission is governed by the institution's Admissions Policy (RIUC002), which, in line with the principles of all relevant legislation, ensures no discriminatory practice and enables us to promote access to tertiary education.

Letters of Recommendation:

Two or three academic or professional references who can attest to the applicant's research abilities and suitability for doctoral study.
