## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Individuals who will be 50 years of age or older by December 31, 2026, are eligible to register. Residency in Bucks County is not required.

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

Registration is required. Walk-on registrations will not be accepted. Each participant must register individually, even if competing with a partner. A valid email address is required to complete registration.

Participants should be physically able to safely compete in their selected events. It is strongly recommended that you consult your healthcare provider prior to participation. Emergency contact information must be provided at the time of registration.

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Registration will open at 8:30 AM on March 20, 2026, and will close at 4:30 PM on May 8, 2026. Registrations received after the deadline will not be accepted.

## FEES

The \$10 registration fee covers participation in all sporting events. Participants may register for as many events as their schedule allows. Please avoid registering for events that overlap in time. Payment must be made by credit or debit card.

**T-shirt sizes are available on a first-come, first-served basis. All fees are non-refundable. Items can be picked up at the Kick-Off event on May 27, 2026.**

## ADDITIONAL EVENT FEES

Some events require additional non-refundable fees, payable directly to the event venue on the day of competition:

### **Bowling: \$10**

Includes three games and optional shoe rental.

### **Golf: \$57**

Includes greens fee, cart rental, a hot dog, and a soda.

## EVENT DROP-INS

After registration closes, participants may only take part in the events for which they have registered. Softball and football throws, frisbee, and chess events allow drop-in participation.

## EVENT CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Every effort will be made to hold all events as scheduled; however, participant safety is our top priority. The Bucks County Senior Games Committee reserves the right to cancel any event if necessary. All registration fees are non-refundable, including in the event of cancellation.

### If an event is cancelled:

- We will try to contact participants, but notification cannot be guaranteed.
- The best way to confirm an event's status is to call the Senior Games phone line and listen to the recorded message.
- Updates will also be available on the Senior Games website and the BCAA Facebook page.

- Efforts will be made to have the phone message, and website updated at least one hour before the scheduled start of the event.
- Participants are encouraged to check the phone line or website before traveling to their event.

### RULES

Complete event rules are available online. Participants are encouraged to review the rules for each event prior to registering or competing: **[www.buckscounty.gov/seniorgames](http://www.buckscounty.gov/seniorgames)**. Event leaders have the right to modify rules or procedures as needed to accommodate participant numbers or ensure smooth competition.

### PICKLEBALL EVALUATIONS

All first-time tournament competitors are required to attend a player evaluation with their partner to determine their skill level. Participants who have already been evaluated by the Senior Games Pickleball Leader do not need to attend another evaluation unless they want to move to a new division. Based on evaluation results, teams will be placed in the appropriate division: beginner, intermediate, or advanced.

### CODE OF CONDUCT

Participants are expected to follow all rules and procedures of the facilities where Bucks County Senior Games (BCSG) events are held. All participants should conduct themselves in a civil, respectful manner and always demonstrate good sportsmanship. BCSG reserves the right to remove anyone from competition who does not follow these standards.

### EVENT DAY INFORMATION

Participants must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of their event to sign in. Brackets will close 10 minutes before the event begins. Participants must be present when brackets are pulled to be eligible to compete. Late arrivals will not be permitted to compete. Competitors are encouraged to bring a hat, sunscreen, water, a snack, and bug spray.



### POST-EVENT RESULTS AND AWARDS

Some events require calculations after the competition ends. Winners will be notified by email or phone. Results will also be posted on the Senior Games website by the end of June. Participants will be given a date and location to pick up their medal, T-shirt, or pin. Any items not collected by the deadline will be forfeited.
