Student Council members, Fr. Brethour, Mrs. Redl and Patrick visited our friends at Kinship Pointe recently.






7<sup>th</sup> grade students spent time in English class researching a historical figure. They created a **bobble head figure** representing their historical figure.








The 6th grade class dissected worms and studied the biology of what makes up a worm. They did a great job, and shared their findings with several others in the school. It was very interesting.
