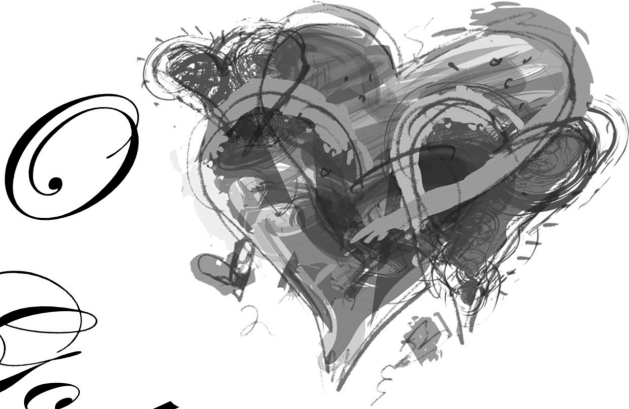

The forty days of Lent bring to mind the forty years of Israel’s sojourn in the wilderness and the forty days of fasting that preceded Jesus’ public ministry. During Lent, Christians around the world reflect on the weight of sin, the cost of salvation, and the love that motivated Jesus’ earthly sojourn and sacrificial death. This year during Lent, find an object that reminds you of the wilderness (like a small stone or a container of sand) and place it in plain sight.
