I am starting to return to the Deaf School this coming week. Most of you know that I still have the Ministry to the Deaf for the Diocese. This means that I will be out of the office in the afternoons on most Wednesdays. Please know, if there is something urgent, Stacey can always get a hold of me. Also, you can always leave a voicemail at the rectory. I do recommend calling the rectory phone outside of office hours as I tend to work from home instead of returning to the office in the afternoon or evening.

Altar Server training is set. There are two options that are, in no way, going to be confusing. The first option is September 22, at St. Mary's at 6:30pm. The second option is on October 22, at St. Mary, at 5pm. Anyone from any of the parishes can participate in either of these trainings. Altar Servers must have received their first communion and be in the 4th Grade or older.

Eucharistic Minister training will be on October 1, at St. Mary, at 6:30pm. The second Training has not been scheduled yet. If you would like to be a Eucharistic Minister and cannot attend the training on October 1, let me know. The first person who commits to the training gets to choose the time and place of the second training.

Anyone, Freshman in High School or older who has received their confirmation and first communion is able to serve as a Eucharistic Minister. This is such a wonderful ministry for the parish. You are bringing Christ to the people of the parish. You are an ambassador of Christ!

Finally, the Church is celebrating a few saints this week. For most of the saints, we celebrate their death. We rejoice for the way that they lived their life. There are just a few that we celebrate their birth. Jesus, of course. St. John the Baptist's birth is celebrated on June 24. And, on September 8th, the Church celebrates the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

On September 9th, the Church in the United States celebrates St. Peter Claver. Peter Claver (1580–1654), was a Spanish Jesuit priest who spent his life tending to the needs of African slaves in Colombia, South America. While serving as a missionary, he ministered to the slaves by providing them with food and medicine, washing their wounds, preparing them for baptism, and witnessing their marriages. He actively recruited lawyers to plead the cases of imprisoned slaves and prepared criminals for death. He not only cared for the slaves but also preached missions to plantation owners and sailors. The "saint of the slaves," as St. Peter is often called, died after contracting the plague.

Friday, September 12 is the Optional Memorial of the Most Holy Name of Mary.

Finally, on Saturday, the Church celebrates St. John Chrysostom. Since antiquity, Church leaders like St. John Chrysostom have urged all Christians to make each home a "family Church." These days we often call a household a "domestic Church."


