VENDORS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The vendor hereby agrees that by signing/submitting an entry form in respect of the above-named sale, that the vendor will be totally bound by the terms and conditions. Entries will be accepted by current financial members of ALBS at the discretion of the NLBS committee and subject to these Terms and Conditions.

1. By submitting entries members are declaring that they:

- Have read and agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions.
- Accept the decisions of the NLBS committee as final and binding.
- And hereby release the inspectors, members of the Sale Committee and the Society from all claims, actions, damages and expenses which may be brought against them.

2. All vendors must be responsible for having their cattle ready for inspections and weighing at 9am Thursday 06 August 2026. If a vendor or their representative is not in attendance the vendor may be charged a handling fee.

3. The vendor accepts that all cattle entered by the vendor for the sale will be inspected by a veterinarian appointed by the sale committee. The vendor accepts that the sale committee shall make inspection decisions from time to time.

4. The vendor will ensure ALL of their sale stock (including calves) are identified with an NLIS device and one other form of permanent identification (tattoo or brand) reflective of the animal's registration record with the ALBS. Brands must be recorded with ALBS prior to the entries being submitted for the sale.

5. All entries are subject to inspection before the sale. This inspection will include the following,
- Verifying both forms of identification are present and legible
 - All required paperwork (Herd health, Pestivirus, and National Vendor Dec) is current.
 - All entries to be polled/ scurred or dehorned.
 - All bulls will be scanned by a sale appointed technician.
 - Assessment by the appointed veterinarian as to each animal's structure, breeding soundness and temperament.
 - Verifying the following entry requirements as to minimum weights and scrotal circumference for bulls with reference to age as at the sale date.

MINIMUM SCROTAL WEIGHT AND CIRCUMFERENCE FOR BULL ENTRIES		
Age Range in Months	Weight	Scrotal Circumference
12 months to 15 months	No minimum weight.	31cm
15 months to 18 months	500kg	32cm
18 months to 21 months	600kg	33cm
21 months to 24 months	700kg	34cm
24 months and over	750kg	35 cm

- 6.** The vendor accepts that the veterinarian or sale committee may reject their entry if in their opinion it does not satisfy the said standards. The vendor agrees to immediately remove any such entry rejected by the inspectors to a holding area as directed by the sale committee.
- 7.** The sale committee may at any time in its absolute discretion as directed by a veterinarian to take a sample of blood, saliva or urine from any animal listed in the sale. In addition, random drug testing of some entries may be carried out. Once results are known, the presence of any drugs not declared in writing to the sale committee prior to the sale will result in that entry being declared null and void and the vendor liable for a full refund of the purchase price and any expenses incurred by the purchaser in relation to transport or cartage of the animal.
- 8.** The vendor accepts the standards and conditions with which entries must comply as issued by the sale committee, current ALBS minimum standards for sale animals and the former LAP guidelines.
- 9.** It is the vendors' responsibility to have all sale animals Docility Scores registered with the ALBS before the data extraction is performed for the sale catalogue, any sale entry that does not have a Docility score on file will either be withdrawn or the vendor will be liable for the fees charged to have the data extraction re-run.
- 10.** Any vendor wishing to place a substitute animal in the sale, will be required to provide the sale committee with a veterinary certificate for the withdrawn animal and will be liable for the data extraction fee to include the substitute animal in the sale.
- 11.** The vendor accepts the breeding history of females as recorded on the ALBS file can be made available to prospective purchasers.
- 12.** No drug, hormone or tranquilliser shall be administered to any animal listed in the sale except under the direction of a veterinarian who shall advise the sale committee if in their opinion such drug, hormone or tranquilliser is likely to have any effect upon the animal behavior in the sale ring.
- 13.** Entries not sold in the sale ring will be \$500 over and above the vendor's reserve, or in the absence of a reserve, the upset price. Negotiations must be conducted in the presence of the agent or his delegate. Vendors who breach this condition may be excluded from future sales run by the Northern Limousin Breeders sale committee.
- 14.** The vendor agrees that the decision of the sale committee is final and binding.
- 15.** The vendor agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions and the vendor hereby absolves the inspectors and the sale committee from all claims, actions and demands, damages and expenses which the vendor may have against the inspectors or the sale committee as a consequence of any rejection.
- 16.** The vendor certifies that the information on the entry form is correct in every respect and in consideration of the sale committee accepting the vendor's entry for sale, the vendor agrees to accept responsibility for and to indemnify the sale committee against all liability that arises from all or part of the information that is misleading or is not correct. The vendor agrees to be totally responsible for all claims and demands that may be made by a purchaser resulting from any information given by the vendor being misleading or not correct or resulting from the vendor not fulfilling any obligation or warranty for which the vendor is responsible and the vendor indemnifies the sale committee against all such claims and demands that may be made by a purchaser against the sale committee.
- 17.** If the vendor consists of more than one person, then these terms and conditions bind them jointly and each of them separately.

18. Any animal entered in the sale that is jointly owned by vendors with separate herd prefixes, are both required to sign the conditions of entry.
19. Any vendor entering cattle in the Northern Limousin Breeders Sale must be a current financial member of Australian Limousin Breeders Society Ltd.
20. All fees and charges are including GST.
21. The sale committee is empowered to determine the vendors and numbers of stock required for the sale.
22. All participating vendors are expected to co-operate in all phases of the conduct of the vetting and sale including assistance to the sale committee when requested.
23. All vendors to warrant sale stock in line with former Limousin Assurance Program.
24. Vendors and their assistants are required to meet the WHS & EM requirements set down by the Scone Saleyards (Council) ie attend and successfully complete a site induction.
25. A vendor meeting will be held at the sale venue after the inspections have been completed or at a time to be appointed, to discuss further conditions of sale and to hear vendors suggestions.
26. Agents commission is 6½% of this ½% will go to the NLBS trust for ongoing cost between annual sales. An additional 2% buyer rebate will apply to qualifying buyers (Agents that are introduced to Nutrien 24 hours prior to sale via writing). Registration transfers are payable by the vendor and will be invoiced by ALBS when a transfer is requested.

- Entry form is complete.
- Signed acceptance of Conditions of Entry.
- Comments to appear in catalogue to be legible and concise maximum 50 words.
- Direct deposit OR Cheque (including GST) payable to NUTRIEN AG SOLUTIONS - SCONE, for entry fees and advertising.
- Dehorning has been done
- Pesti Virus testing carried out

On inspection day

- National Vendor Declaration has been completed and given to the selling agent.
- National Cattle Health Declaration form to be given to the committee or selling agent
- Pestivirus Health Status (PI negative) to be given to the committee or selling agent
