

RECIPIENT DAM INPUT FORM

Before a calf born after embryo transfer can be registered, the details of the recipient cow must be recorded on the database.

Where a registered Limousin female is used as a recipient, details will already be available. This form is to be completed when a commercial female is used to carry a Limousin embryo.

Recipient cow details can be submitted before or after the birth of a calf and only need to be lodged the first time the recipient is used.

The Regulations of the ALBS indicate that:

4.5.1 For Base or Grade 0 cattle, a full ident. number is required for registration with the relevant Herd Identification, the Grade of 0, the year of birth code (for age or approx. age) and identification number.

4.5.2 Animals used as recipients, unless already registered in their own right, are required to be identified in the same manner and recorded on the database.

Once completed, this form should be forwarded to the ALBS Registrars by post or email registrar@genetichub.com.au

(Note that section 6.4 of the Regulations require that should a pregnant recip be sold, the vendor should notify the ALBS of this via a "Transfer Form" and also notify the ALBS of the transfer of the embryo she is carrying via an "Application for the Transfer of Embryos" form. The resultant calf will then be eligible for registration by the new owner.)
