DEAR HAITI KIDS SCHOOL COMMUNITY,

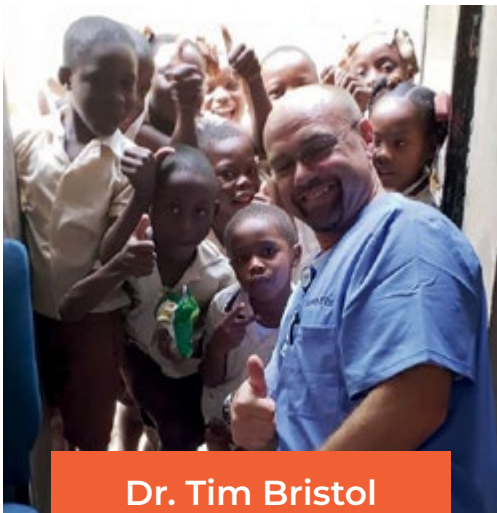
We are deeply grateful for your generous support and faithful partnership in prayer, which have made Haiti Kids School's continued impact possible.

The past year has seen Haiti confronting intensifying challenges that continue to test the resilience of its people. The nation has experienced persistent civil unrest and escalating violence, particularly in Port-au-Prince where gang activity has effectively paralyzed significant portions of the city and continues to spread to other previously peaceful areas of the country.

This deteriorating security situation has prompted travel bans from multiple countries, further isolating Haiti at a time when engagement from those with a heart for Haiti and a desire to assist is critically needed.

Economic hardships have mounted as the prices of essential goods have risen sharply, placing basic necessities out of reach for many families. Resources that were already scarce have become even more difficult to obtain, with fuel shortages and disruptions to food supply chains and medical care, creating a multifaceted humanitarian crisis.

Through it all, Haiti Kids School remains steadfast in our mission to provide assistance under the guidance of our in-country Haitian leadership and liaisons in Léogâne, Haiti. We remain committed to supporting Haiti through these difficult times, adapting our approach to the evolving situation while maintaining our focus on sustainable, locally led education initiatives that empower Haitian children to know the love of Jesus and build a brighter future for themselves and their nation.

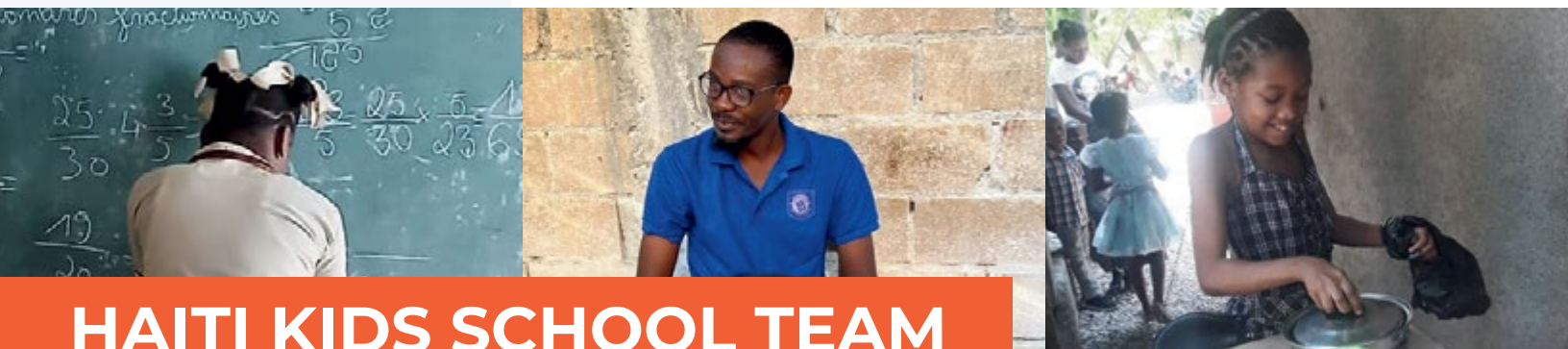
