- Must own and live in the home in need of repair.
- Must have homeowner's insurance
- Must be current on mortgage payments, property taxes, and utilities.
- Must have DD-214 and Honorable Discharge papers
- Income must be 80% or below Area Median Income (AMI) based on Household Size
