All children are valuable to God and to us. No matter what's on their little hearts, we are ready to listen.




**Jesus loves to hear your voice

songs of praise.**




**The leaders at your church love to hear

can tell!




If something feels

person, you can tell.




Some kinds of touching are great, like high-fives and fist bumps, but we must always be careful to touch each other in only the right ways.




No one should ever touch

you can tell.




Going to the bathroom is private time. When you go to the bathroom you should be left alone. If someone bothers you in the bathroom, you can tell.
