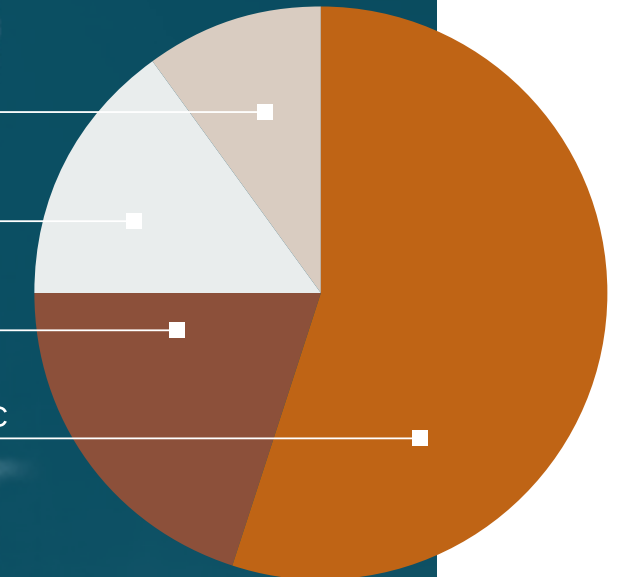

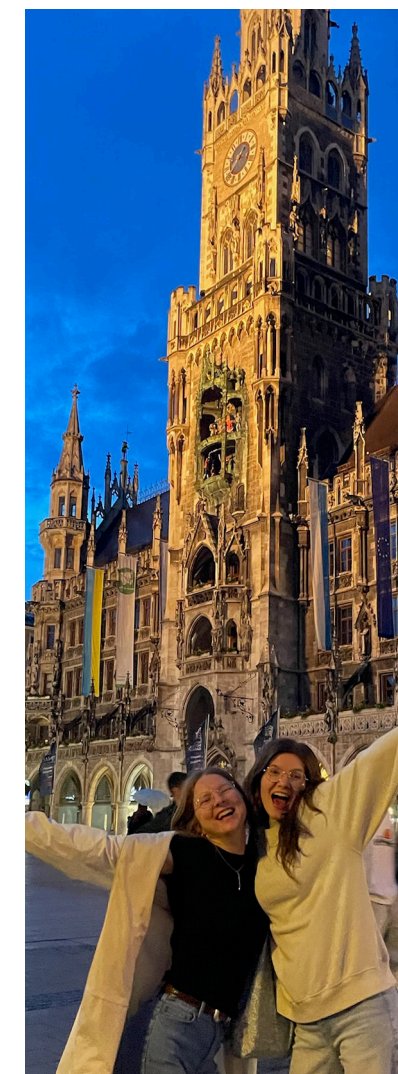

INTERNATIONAL MISSION BOARD

The International Mission Board (IMB) has faithfully been on mission for over 175 years. Since its founding, almost 25,000 Southern Baptist Missionaries have shared the gospel, made disciples, and planted churches in 185 countries around the world.

IMB addresses the problem of lostness in the world that affects billions people today. Through their missionaries all over the world they are carrying out the Great Commission to make disciples of all nations. The IMB is working toward the vision God gave the church in Revelation 7:9. They do this every day.

Their missionaries go to people in hard-to-reach places to provide gospel access and plant churches. The missionaries work to glorify God by proclaiming the gospel, advancing the church, walking in the Spirit, praying fervently, and being Biblically faithful.

They have missionaries serving European, Central Asian, American, North African/ Middle Eastern, Asian Pacific Rim, South Asian, Sub-Saharan African, and Deaf peoples.

North American Mission Board

An estimated 286 million people in North America do not have a relationship with Jesus. The goal of the North American Mission Board (NAMB) is to equip families and individuals to find their role in spreading the hope of the gospel across North America.

NAMB helps equip churches to be on mission in their own communities and across the continent. Through compassion ministry, church planting, chaplaincy and disaster relief, they help congregations go to the lost and hurting.

Two main ways NAMB is reaching North America is through the Send Network and Send Relief. The Send Network plants and connects churches across North America. Send Relief offers resources, training, and events to support those in crisis.

NAMB is also investing in the future generation of church planters through the GenSend program. GenSend allows students to serve alongside NAMB church planters as interns.

They have missionaries serving across the United States, Puerto Rico, and Canada.

Missouri Baptist Disaster Relief (MODR) transforms lives and communities with the gospel by bringing help, hope, and healing. Churches participate in MODR by praying, giving, and going. MODR helps churches by providing leadership, discipleship, and sending opportunities. The organization provides free services to everyone affected by a disaster without discrimination. MODR is a platform for ministry.

MODR recruits, trains, and deploys volunteers to help others in a time of crisis. They average one activation every three weeks for state, national, and international disasters. Through ownership or partnership, they manage 82 pieces of

rolling stock, including mobile kitchens, shower units, flood and wind cleanup units, and childcare. Over 2,000 Missouri Baptists participate as trained, credentialed volunteers seeking to be on mission.

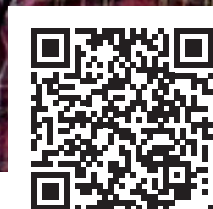

We offer a comprehensive martial arts program that has no class fee for our communities in Springfield and Rogersville. Each class trains the mind and body for self-defense, personal growth, and most importantly we share the Love of God and the gospel message with all of the students every class!

PRAY: Pray that students and families would encounter the love of Christ through training and devotions. Pray for more salvations and baptisms, and for lasting discipleship beyond the mats. Please pray that God would empower the next generation of student leaders and coaches to rise up and be bold for Christ on their school campuses and athletic teams.



M.E.N.D. (MOMMIES ENDURING NEONATAL DEATH)

M.E.N.D. is here to provide hope and healing to families after the loss of a baby. M.E.N.D. (Mommies Enduring Neonatal Death) is a Christian, non-profit organization that reaches out to families who have suffered the loss of a baby through miscarriage, stillbirth, or early infant death. We publish free bi-monthly magazines, hold commemorative ceremonies, and host a variety of support groups throughout the nation, including here in Springfield, MO. M.E.N.D. is a place for families to connect, share their unique story of loss, and learn to live life without your precious baby. Together we are breaking down the barriers associated with the isolation and sadness of pregnancy and infant loss as we strive to turn our children's lives into legacies.

PRAY: We have so many hurting hearts who come to us from early losses, multiple losses, losses later in pregnancy, and some weeks after birth. These families are not only mourning the loss of their baby and their future dreams, many are facing unfathomable circumstances, and we provide a place of safety and comfort where they can share these struggles. We pray we will always lean into the Holy Spirit to know how to care for these families and let them see Jesus in us.



NIGHTLIGHT INTERNATIONAL / MISSOURI

NightLight is an international organization compelled by love to reach out to, rescue, and restore all those who are negatively impacted by sex trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation. NightLight Missouri extends that mission to individuals locally who are in need of light in the darkness right here in our community. Vision: To offer intervention to sexually exploited women and children, to enable them to discover their dignity, and to provide a program of holistic transformation, empowering them to live and work in their community.

PRAY: Pray for the women that we are consistently working with through our programs. They have many challenges and barriers, even as they make forward progress. We need the Lord to change hearts and bring real transformation and healing. Pray for our staff and volunteers as we go into the dark places of our community and listen to the hard things that are shared with us. Pray for faithfulness, perseverance, and opportunities to sow seeds of hope and God's love into every encounter. Pray for NightLight's leadership as they continue to seek wisdom, vision, and opportunities to connect with women who need our support, both in the US and in Thailand.



MISSOURI BAPTIST CHILDREN'S HOME (MBCH)

We are a Christian organization connecting children, youth and families to Hope, Healing, and Restoration.

PRAY: We need 4 foster families (individuals or couples) to say YES to Treatment Family Care fostering and 10 families to say YES to respite foster care for our current TFC foster homes.



PREGNANCY CARE CENTER

PCC believes every person experiencing an untimely pregnancy should have access to a personalized plan, a coach, and the information they need for a healthier future so they, and our community, can be stronger together. PCC offers pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and compassionate care, all free of charge.

PRAY: PCC will always ask for prayer, first and foremost. Pray for our clients, our staff, and that a culture of life will prevail in our community. Second, we ask for our partners to be advocates. The number one way clients hear about PCC is through word-of-mouth. Third, financial support from our partners is what allows us to do what we do. We are thankful for the faithful, consistent support from Second Baptist.



SAFE TO SLEEP

Safe to Sleep is a shelter for women 18 and older who are experiencing homelessness in the Springfield and surrounding areas. We also offer case management and supportive services for women who are seeking permanent housing.

PRAY: Our fundraising goal for our new shelter has increased from our original goal due to increased construction and contractor costs. Please be in prayer for our fundraising team as they work to secure these additional funds. Also please pray for our guests. Many are first time homeless and scared, unsure of next steps and have no support system. Please pray we can meet them where they are and walk alongside them as they navigate a path towards housing.



SCHOOL TO THE NATIONS

School to the Nations has been reaching the final frontiers for the glory of Jesus by mobilizing the next generation to the nations. We produce a dramatic motion picture of God's redemptive story from Creation to Christ called "The HOPE." This film is translated into the language of the unreached people group and contextualized for their culture. We are now engaging over 134 distinct unreached people groups-- nearly 400 million people from South America, North American Native Americans, Africa, India, and Asia.

PRAY: We are in over 200 languages among some of the most remote and hostile high security fields. Please pray for God's continued provision and for fruitfulness.



VICTORY GARDEN

Victory Garden is a volunteer-based vegetable garden that provides fresh produce for local-area ministries to feed the hungry, the homeless, and shut-ins. Since its inception, Victory Garden has provided over 175,000 pounds of produce to Ozarks Food Harvest.

PRAY: We are in need of more volunteers. Pray for the Lord of the Harvest to send more workers into this field.



VICTORY MISSION

Victory Mission is a local ministry in Springfield, Missouri, and operates the largest shelter for men in Southwest Missouri. Our programs serve men and women through discipleship, recovery, and job training. Victory also operates social enterprises, including Equip Coffee, which provide hands-on training and sustainable support for our programs.

PRAY: You can partner with Victory Mission in prayer by lifting up the men and women who are ready to leave homelessness, poverty, and life-controlling issues behind. Pray that they would see God's unique design for their life and begin to walk in step with Him. Pray that each person would develop meaningful relationships that lead them toward true freedom in Christ.
