

Why We Are Here

The Numbers That Truly Matter

In the year 2000, **90,000** people in **Greene County** reported having no religious affiliation whatsoever. Just a few years before that, God led us to this campus at 3111 East Battlefield Road. By His providence, He placed us here to be a light—a city on a hill, a beacon in the darkness, a kingdom-outpost for Christ.

It matters that we are here.

It matters that we gather, that we go, and that we engage our community.

This campus isn't simply where we meet—it is where God has planted us.

The Need Around Us

A Growing Mission Field

By 2010, the number of people unaffiliated with any faith had grown from **90,000** to **130,000**. These aren't individuals identifying as non-Christian—these are individuals identifying with no faith community at all.

This is the world around us. This is the world God has called us to reach.

"We live in a world lost in darkness—and that is why our presence here matters."

God has directed Second Baptist Church to be woven into the fabric of this community for generations. And He is calling us to look ahead with faith, expectation, and readiness.

Stewarding God's Provision

Caring for Today, Preparing for Tomorrow

In 2022, the church affirmed a long-term master plan to care for our facilities and strengthen our ministry infrastructure.

We divided that plan into two phases so we could steward wisely and move forward with clarity.

Phase One was completed under budget at \$9.6 million.

Now we stand at the threshold of Phase Two, believing God is leading us into a season of sowing, investing, and future-building.

"To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven." — Ecclesiastes 3:1

We want to be faithful in this season—faithful to the mission, faithful to the community God has placed around us, and faithful to steward what He has entrusted to us.





Kingdom First. Second Strong. More Than a Mission Statement

You've heard us often speak the phrase: "Kingdom First. Second Strong."—It is a mindset.

We are not here to make Second Baptist Church famous.

We are here to make Jesus famous.

God has placed us here, and we want to steward this campus, this calling, and this moment for His glory.

At the same time, we must be a strong congregation—able and ready to do all that God desires to accomplish through us.

How We Got Here: The Master Plan

In 2021, the facilities audit revealed a wide range of needs—some urgent, some moderate, some overdue—just like in any home.

The Campus Strategy Team collaborated to form a comprehensive master plan addressing:

- Building systems and lifespan
- Deferred maintenance
- Functional improvements
- Maximizing ministry environments

The master plan originally projected a cost of a little over \$20 million, divided into:

Phase One — Completed at **\$9.6 million**

Phase Two — Estimated at **\$11.5 million**

Phase Two includes the worship center, adult spaces, and office spaces.



Our Current Financial Position

PHASE ONE

RECEIVED & PAID: \$7.62 MILLION

REMAINING DEBT: \$1.98 MILLION

ACTUAL COST: \$9.6 MILLION

In Phase 2 we remain committed to keeping debt below \$5.5 million once pledges are fulfilled consistent with church-approved limits. Estimated Cost: \$11.5 Million

Two Key Congregational Moments

1. September 7 — Vote to Proceed

On this date, the church voted:

"Do you affirm proceeding with Phase Two, not to exceed \$5.5 million in debt after pledges are fulfilled?"

Affirmation authorized us to:

- Complete construction documents
- Prepare accurate bids
- Stay on project timeline

No borrowing of funds began here.
This step is about readiness, not indebtedness.

2. February 8 — Pledge Sunday One Service at 9:30am

On this date, we will each prayerfully bring our three-year pledge toward Phase Two.

Pledge results will be announced on February 22.
