This permit is issued subject to the strict observance of Resolution No. 30 adopted on June 30, 1994, by the Reading Area Water Authority (RAWA). The permittee shall assume full responsibility for use, operation, repair and/or replace, if damage of the fire hydrant and hydrant metering assembly occurs, and will keep unauthorized persons from using or tampering with the fire hydrant and hydrant metering assembly. The use of the hydrant shall only be between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. At the end of each day the fire hydrant shall be turned off and the hydrant metering assembly removed and stored in a non-freezing environment.

This permit is subject to revocation by the RAWA in the event of the failure of the permittee to comply with the terms or conditions upon which this permit is granted.

A daily flat fee charge of **\$10.00** per day for the $\frac{3}{4}$ " and **\$20.00** per day for the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " connection and a water usage fee of \$13.76 per 1000 gallons used will be billed when the hydrant metering connection is removed. Permits are available from April through October each year. A \$2,000 fee will be assessed if hydrant metering assembly is not returned to RAWA within 30 days of the WORK TO BE COMPLETED ON OR BEFORE date above.

This permit shall not become valid until it bears the official signature of the Executive Director of RAWA or their designee.
