Youth Shares Her TFO Experience

"When I was younger, I was in a really bad situation with my [bio.] parents that were addicted to drugs. The Too Far Out Farm Christian ministry has helped me with my trauma from my past. I learned horses have fears just like we do and that we have to look at fears straight in the eye and say, "I am saved by Jesus and you can't do anything about it!" 
TFO Farm Facility Spotlight: NEW BARN ROOF

After several setbacks associated with finding an appropriate trainer to get Faith started under saddle, we have landed on a solution ... at least for the winter.

Daniel is a 17-year old young man who has agreed to "join-up" with Debbie to follow the *Carson James(R) HorseTracks Training System* as a means to keep Faith learning the finer points of serving her humans. Together, Daniel and Debbie are working on deepening Faith's understanding of the basics: leading behind and at the shoulder, leading & grooming at liberty, introduction to the saddle, handling feet, lateral movements: hips/shoulders, straightness, speed transitions, stopping, reins (ground driving), etc.


