A Christmas Promise Kept

Jesus' parents were amazed at what was being said about him. Then Simeon blessed them, and he said to Mary, the baby's mother, "This child is destined to cause many in Israel to fall, and many others to rise. He has been sent as a sign from God, but many will oppose him." ~Luke 2:33-34 (NLT)

According to the story of Jesus' birth in Luke, Chapter 2, Simeon was given a promise by God, He was told that he would see the Messiah before he died. Simeon believed and obeyed The Lord. (Believers obey; obedience is evidence of belief.) The Bible calls Simeon a righteous man, because He believed God's promises. When baby Jesus was brought to Jerusalem to be presented to the Lord by his earthly parents, Simeon went to the Temple, because God, through the Holy Spirit led him there. Simeon believed and obeyed the Lord's leading. Then Simeon received the fulfillment of the promise of God. He saw the Messiah!

Simeon obeyed because he believed. He believed so completely that He actually sensed the Lord speaking a command directly to him, personally. Not only that, he chose to obey the command, because He recognized His Lord's voice and believed He would be blessed by this God who he believed loved him.

Do you think God would have kept his promise to Simeon had he not gone to the Temple, as The Lord instructed? God's promises are not dependent upon our obedience, but by obeying The Lord immediately, our prayers go unhindered and are not delayed by our foolish pride and stubborn rebellion.

Food for thought... What promise of God is, as yet unfulfilled in your life? Are you waiting for God to move? Or is He waiting on you? Re-read the verse at the beginning of this article, especially: "He has been sent as a sign from God, but many will oppose him." Will Jesus' coming cause you to rise or fall?
