**Water bottles:** Dancers are encouraged to stay hydrated. Please be sure the water bottles or containers have lids when bringing them into the studio rooms. **Only water is permitted in the dance rooms.** 

**Restroom breaks:** Please make sure your dancer has gone to the bathroom before class begins. Sometimes, our younger dancers experience the need for a lot of bathroom breaks during class. This can't always be avoided, but it can interfere with class. Therefore, we would really appreciate it if you could make sure your dancer has gone to the bathroom before class begins. This helps minimize restroom breaks during class.

## Fees to expect (other than monthly tuition):

<u>Tights/Recital costumes:</u> Invoices for recital costumes will be distributed to parents in November with payment due in full by mid December. Tights will be invoiced in January with payments due in February. We understand that these payments can be difficult, so please plan accordingly. We do this so that costumes can be ordered during the holiday break in order to receive all costumes in a timely manner.

<u>Recital fee/tickets:</u> Invoices for the recital fee will also be distributed in February. Ticket sales will begin in April. We like to give this information now so you can plan accordingly and be prepared for the expenses for the year. <u>Recital Pictures/videos:</u> These are optional items. Forms for both will be distributed this spring.
