**NEW THIS YEAR!** Cash scholarships will be guaranteed to select dancers who participate and will be announced for each age group during Saturday's awards sessions.

## ✦ SOLO TITLE COMPETITION

**NEW THIS YEAR!** ALL dancers who compete a Solo at the Stage 8 Dance Grand Finale will be required to participate in the Title Competition for the chance to be named Stage 8 Performer of the Year. The Solo Title competition is offered for all ages and performance levels (Premier and Rising Talent). Dancers will compete their solo and participate in an improv competition and brief interview.

# BID INFORMATION

## PLATINUM BID

- ★ Guaranteed Advancement to Finals on Day 2
- ★ One Time Dancer Registration Fee waived for each dancer on the receiving team
- ★ Routine Performance Fee waived for each dancer on the receiving team
- ★ \$200 Per Dancer Hotel Stipend at the Hilton Orlando\*see details below

## GOLD BID

- ★ Guaranteed Advancement to Finals on Day 2
- ★ Routine Performance Fee waived for each dancer on the receiving team
- ★ \$100 Per Dancer Hotel Stipend at the Hilton Orlando\*see details below

## SILVER BID

- ★ Guaranteed Advancement to Finals on Day 2
- ★ Routine Performance Fee waived for each dancer on the receiving team

## BRONZE BID

- ★ Guaranteed Advancement to Finals on Day 2

**Note: The amount of dancers competing at the Regional event where a bid is earned will be the amount of dancer credit that will be received for the Grand Finale. If less dancers compete at the Grand Finale, you will receive credit for only the dancers taking the stage at the Grand Finale. Example: 20 dancers compete at Regionals, but only 15 compete at the Grand Finale. You will receive credit for the 15 dancers attending the Grand Finale.**

### OTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS:

- The number of bids awarded at each Stage 8 Dance Brands event can be found [\*\*HERE\*\*](#)
- Guaranteed Advancement to Finals means a team will compete in the 1<sup>st</sup> round on Day 1 and regardless of placement, will advance to Finals on Day 2.
- Teams can upgrade their bid. Example: Junior Jazz earns a gold bid, then at another event earns a platinum bid. The Junior Jazz will drop their gold bid and upgrade to platinum.
- A dancer who earns multiple bids for different teams will receive the highest bid they earned, and each additional bid will cover the Routine Performance Fees with the exception of a bronze bid.
- A minimum of the top half of each division will advance to finals. In divisions of 3 or less, all teams will move on to finals.
- If your team does not have a bid and they place higher than a team with a bid, it does not guarantee your advancement to finals.
- **NEW THIS YEAR!** Hotel stipend received with platinum and gold bids are total per dancer. These are not accumulative. Dancers will only receive the amount for the highest bid level earned. The hotel stipend is valid for the Hilton Orlando under Stage 8's group block and will be received after hotel check-in is completed.

# SOLO/TITLE COMPETITION FOR STAGE 8 PERFORMER OF THE YEAR

**NEW THIS YEAR! The Title Competition is required for ALL registered soloists and is available for ALL ages and performance levels (Premier and Rising Talent).**

## **Details:**

- The Title Competition for Performer of the Year will take place on Friday and Saturday. Times for each age group will be announced on the preliminary schedule.
- The Title Competition consists of 3 parts:
  - Solo Routine: maximum 2:30 (2 minutes & 30 seconds). The Stage 8 Solo Score Sheet (100 points) will be utilized.
  - Interview: The dancer will introduce themselves, state their age and where they are from, and be asked 1 interview question. This interview will be scored out of a maximum of 50 points.
  - Improv: After the completion of the solo competition, the dancers in each age group will be invited on-stage to perform 6-8 8-counts of improv each. The improv portion will be scored out of a maximum of 50 points.
- Scoring criteria for Title Competition:
  - Solo Routine: 100 points. Weighted at 60% of total Title Score
  - Interview: 50 points
  - Improv: 50 points
  - Interview & Improv score will be totaled (out of 100 points) and weighted at 40% of total Title Score
- Dancers will wear the solo costume of their choice throughout all portions of the Title competition
- Performer of the Year Title Winners will receive *cash prizes and more!*

# OPENING NUMBER PERFORMANCE INFORMATION

## **Who can participate and when are selections due?**

Each program can select up to 5 dancers per team to participate in the Opening Number. Please email the number of dancers representing your program in the Opening Number no later than Wednesday, April 1st to [Molly@stage8dance.com](mailto:Molly@stage8dance.com).

## **What routine will the dancers perform?**

Videos will be available on Stage 8 Dance Brands' YouTube channel for each age group to learn their section of the Opening Number routine. The age groups will be divided as tiny/mini, youth, and junior/senior. Dancers should learn their section of the routine before they arrive in Orlando.

## **What is the rehearsal schedule?**

There will be two short rehearsals during the event. Rehearsal times for each age group will be announced after the final performance order is released. These rehearsals will be mandatory for dancers who are participating in the Opening Number. The attire for rehearsals is casual dance clothes that are comfortable with tennis shoes.

## **What is the genre/style of the Opening Number routine?**

Showy, fun, and visual with no technical skills. As the ages increase, we might incorporate more intricate staging and movement without technical skills. We want this to be fun, entertaining, stress-free and memorable for the dancers!

## **What will the dancers wear for the Opening Number Performance?**

Each dancer can select the costume of their choice to perform in.

## **NEW THIS YEAR!**

Cash scholarships will be guaranteed to select dancers who participate and will be announced for each age group during Saturday's awards sessions! Dancers must be present at both rehearsals to be eligible for a cash scholarship.
