### Honoring the Crew and Passengers of United Flight 93

The Remember Me Rose Garden is a living tribute to the crew and passengers aboard United Flight 93, who sacrificed their own lives to save countless others in a remote field in Shanksville, PA, during the 9/11 attack on America.

Situated just ¼-mile east of the entrance to the Flight 93 National Memorial, the Remember Me Rose Garden offers a tranquil setting for remembrance, prayer, meditation, and healing.

The 13-acre site was donated by the Families of the Heroes of Flight 93 in 2009 for the construction of the Remember Me Rose Garden — seeding the creation of a living memorial to honor their loved ones.

#### The Remember Me Rose Garden features:

-  A large, floral compass design spanning 280 feet
-  A 30-foot fountain and reflecting pond in the center of the compass
-  40 memorial stones engraved with each of the names of the heroes of Flight 93
-  350 award-winning “Julie Andrews” pink rose bushes, named for the iconic actress and performer
-  600+ flowering perennials of various colors and sizes
-  A 16-foot-tall wooden cross -- the first memorial erected at the actual Flight 93 crash site
-  A ½-mile walking trail that nearly encircles the site, with benches placed intermittently for rest and prayer

## Ryan's Trail

Enjoy "Ryan's Trail" — conceived and constructed by the late Ryan Cenk, whose Eagle Scout Project furnished all the teakwood benches thoughtfully arranged along a 1/2-mile trail — ideal for reflection, rest, and meditation.



## The Family Rock

Near the entrance stands a massive rock that gratefully acknowledges the donation of the Rose Garden's property by "The Families of Flight 93," a nonprofit corporation formed by the families of the fallen heroes.
