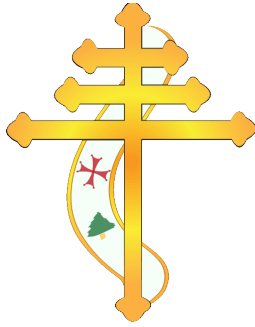

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

This month, we celebrate the Week of the Priests. In the Gospel reading from Luke, our Lord tells us: "From everyone to whom much has been given, much will be required; and from the one to whom much has been entrusted, even more will be demanded." This holds true for all Christians but especially those in the ordained ministry. The threefold ministry of Bishop, Priest and Deacon emerged during the first century and has remained with us ever since. It is a ministry of service within the Church and for its members. One of the titles of the Holy Father is 'Servant of the Servants of God' and the Pallium which he and Archbishops wear over their vestments is always made of wool as a reminder that the Good Shepherd laid the lost sheep across his shoulders and carried it gently back to the flock.

Our Lord is only referred to as a priest in the Letter to the Hebrews. He was not a priest in Judaism nor did he come from a priestly family and yet his is the example on which the ordained ministry in the Church is modeled. Ours is not a sacrificial ministry but a pastoral one. We are called upon to be leaders, teachers, healers, preachers, reconcilers and good stewards or managers of the gifts and responsibilities entrusted to us. There was a time when priests, and especially bishops, behaved like a sort of clerical aristocracy and regarded themselves as masters rather than servants but that was not the way it was and not the way it is intended to be. The clergy, (bishops, priests, and deacons) are servants of the People of God, called to live lives of personal holiness, dedication, prayer and service. We can only discharge our responsibilities when these are the characteristics of our lives. We call to mind the characteristics that are required to be leaders, teachers, healers, reconcilers and good stewards or managers of the gifts and responsibilities entrusted to them.

Our Lord is the pattern and exemplar for all but especially those in the ordained ministry. We are called to show his compassion, understanding, willingness to forgive and also to confront evil and expose hypocrisy just as Our Lord did with the Scribes and the Pharisees. As clergy, we are called upon to proclaim the Good News not only by our words but by lives that bear witness to Our Lord's values. Ours is not a sacrificial ministry but it is a self-sacrificial ministry and one which none of us could possibly carry out but for the Grace of God and the prayers of the faithful.
