Why Santa Barbara? Why Now?

Santa Barbara has always been a place where the world looks for inspiration.

- In 1969, when an oil spill blackened our coast, we rose up and created the modern environmental movement.
- In **2017 and 2018**, when fires and floods struck, we came together as neighbors and survivors.
- Today, we face a new choice: do we wait for the next disaster, or do we build something stronger together?

Fairness 4 is about giving **our people**, **our businesses**, **and our environment a fair chance** at a safe, thriving future.

And it begins here, in Santa Barbara County.

What is Fairness 4?

Fairness 4 is a new community framework built on three simple but powerful pillars:

Fairness 4 Hope

- Hope is where everything begins.
- Just like Sylvia Earle's "Hope Spots" in the ocean, we propose Santa Barbara County as a framework for hope on both land and sea.
- A place where truth still matters, where we protect what we love, and where the future can still be fair.

Fairness 4 Being Alerted

- Alerts are about **trust and survival**.
- When a fire spreads, when rain turns to flood, when State Street closes and we clog the heart of our city — alerts matter.
- Fairness 4 proposes a **stronger**, **citizen-driven alert system** that builds on **Alert California** and brings timely, accurate information to every household.
- Being alerted is the difference between danger and safety.



Fairness 4 Our Response

- Hope alone is not enough. Response is action.
- Santa Barbara's past disasters have shown us where response worked and where it failed.
- Fairness 4 Response means clear coordination, accountability, and community-based action so that no one is left behind.

- For Families: Trusted alerts to protect your loved ones.
- For Businesses: Smarter systems that keep Santa Barbara thriving.
- For Students & Youth: A model of resilience and fairness you can carry forward.
- For All of Us: Pride in making Santa Barbara the first place in the world to show what true fairness looks like.

Our Vision

Imagine this:

- A Santa Barbara where every resident is **alerted in time**.
- A Santa Barbara where responses are **swift**, **coordinated**, **and transparent**.
- A Santa Barbara that once again inspires the world just like we did in 1969, when Earth Day began here.

This is our chance to build a new kind of fairness — for our streets, our seas, and our future.

Proposed Actions

1. Fairness 4 Hope

- Declare Fairness 4 Santa Barbara County.
- Partner with UCSB, Channel Islands National Marine Sanctuary, and community organizations.
- Build education and storytelling initiatives to engage citizens.



2. Fairness 4 Being Alerted

- Conduct an audit of the county's current alert systems.
- Integrate with Alert California and expand with citizen-based sensor networks.
- Launch a pilot program to monitor:
 - o Traffic congestion and State Street vitality.
 - o Disaster risks (wildfires, floods, storms).
 - o Environmental health indicators (coastal water quality, air quality).

3. Fairness 4 Our Response

- Create a **unified response coalition** that includes fire departments, law enforcement, county agencies, and community leaders.
- Establish benchmarks for response times, coordination, and recovery outcomes.
- Leverage UCSB research capacity and local nonprofits to evaluate performance and publish results.

Funding & Resources

Fairness 4 will seek a public-private partnership model:

- County of Santa Barbara: policy adoption, integration, oversight.
- State of California: disaster resilience and climate funding streams.
- Federal Grants: FEMA, NOAA, DOE resilience programs.
- **Private Sector & Philanthropy**: partnerships with tech companies, foundations, and local businesses.
- Concerned Citizens: The heart of Fairness 4. Every program begins and succeeds with engaged, informed, and empowered community members.
