Rich Dunning said they are expecting to receive their SPEDES permit around July 31. He will put an ad in the paper about the changes to the permit. Thirty days later the new permit will go into effect. The UV disinfection project has been moved back. The new completion date is May 31, 2023. He is still waiting for the solid waste permit renewal. It is going out for a 30-day comment period before it is sent to us. The flow differential between the two plants has been minimal.

Mitch Cornish informed us that the Canisteo Street bridge is on schedule. They have been having some issues with getting materials due to COVID-19. The WTP project is 98% complete. The tanks are done and they are waiting on the topsoil analysis so that they can plant grass. Contract #2 is having a valving issue with backwash valves. They are working on getting a different type of valve up there. Contract #3 has just started to do the SKATA work. With streets, North Church, Willow and State streets are ready to go for paving. Then Elm Street, River, Hill and Greeley Lane. They have been trying to keep up with mowing. They will be losing the summer kids soon.
