As a mom to a student with dyslexia, I understand the stress and uncertainty parents feel when their child isn't learning to read as expected. My goal is to make sure both parents and students feel supported on this journey and know they are not alone.

I began my path into literacy education during COVID, when my son lost access to both his classroom teacher and dyslexia interventionist. I have a Master of Science in Education - Literacy and Dyslexia from the University of Central Arkansas and my Certified Structured Literacy Dyslexia Specialist (C-SLDS) credential from The Center for Effective Reading Instruction (CERI).

Location & Waiting Options

Sessions are held at my office, located at 1801 Forest Hills Blvd., Suite 114B, Bella Vista, AR 72715. Parents are always welcome! You are welcome to sit in and observe the session, relax in the waiting area or the building's common spaces, wait in your car, or drop your student off for their session.

If you choose to drop off your student and have not returned by the end of the session, they will be instructed to wait for you in the waiting area of the ODS office.

Restrooms

Public restrooms are located near the main entrance to the building. Please make sure your student has an opportunity to use the restroom before our session. If your child needs to use the restroom during our session and you are not available, I will escort your child to the restroom and wait for them in the common area outside the restroom.

Parking

Please observe the parking information signs in the parking lot. The best places to park are outside Entrance A and Entrance C.

Session Length

Sessions begin on the hour and typically last 45 to 50 minutes — sometimes called a “therapy hour.” The exact length may vary slightly depending on lesson pacing and when we reach a natural stopping point. Please arrive on time so we can make the most of our session. If a student arrives late, we’ll still end at the scheduled time in order to stay on track for the next learner.

Assessments and Progress Reports

Every student begins with an initial assessment. From there, I use informal checks during sessions to guide instruction and track progress in real time. In addition, I use formal progress monitoring assessments at the middle and end of the academic year. You’ll receive a written progress report at those times so you can see how your child is growing.

I’m always happy to talk about your child’s progress at any time. If you need written documentation for your child’s school, please let me know with plenty of notice so I can prepare the necessary documents.

Cancellation Policy

Life happens — and so do colds, stomach bugs, and unexpected hiccups in the schedule. If your child is sick, please keep them home to rest and recover. I appreciate your help in keeping everyone healthy.

Each student is allowed 2 make-up sessions per academic semester (Fall and Spring). These sessions will be scheduled during the last 2 weeks of the semester (see the blue weeks on the attached calendar). No refunds or make-ups will be scheduled for the 3rd or subsequent absences.

If cancellations become frequent or ongoing, we may need to reevaluate services, as consistency is key to making progress.

Any session I need to cancel will be credited towards the next month's invoice. I will communicate with you as early as I can regarding any cancellations.

Payment Policy

Clients will be invoiced on the first day of each month for all sessions scheduled that month. **Payment is due within 10 days, by the 10th of the month.** Invoices can be paid by check, Venmo, or credit card.

If you plan to use an Educational Freedom Account (EFA) through ClassWallet, you will be invoiced for the entire semester in advance.

Payments not received by the **15th of the month** will incur a \$15 late fee. If a balance remains unpaid for more than 30 days, services may be paused until payment is received.

Weather Related Closings

If the weather gets rough, safety comes first. Ozark Dyslexia Services will follow **Gravette and Bentonville Public Schools** for weather-related closures. If **either** district cancels school or dismisses early due to inclement weather, our sessions will also be canceled for the day.

Sessions that are canceled due to weather will be credited towards the next month's invoice. I'll keep in touch and communicate any changes as early as I can. If you're ever unsure, feel free to reach out — I'm happy to confirm the day's plans!
