Location & Waiting Options

All sessions are held in person at my home office. Parents are always welcome! You can sit in during the session, relax at the table across the hall (Wi-Fi is available), enjoy the front patio, wait in your car, or drop your student off for their session.

Siblings are also welcome to come along, as long as they're able to sit quietly and not distract from the lesson. If you choose to drop off your child, please plan to return by the 45-minute mark, as I'm unable to provide supervision after our session ends.

Parking

You may park in my main driveway on the right or left side (please leave center free). You are also welcome to park on the secondary driveway or on the side of the road in front of the house.

Session Length

Sessions begin on the hour and typically last 45 to 50 minutes — sometimes called a "therapy hour." The exact length may vary slightly depending on lesson pacing and when we reach a natural stopping point. Please arrive on time so we can make the most of our session. If a student arrives late, we'll still end at the scheduled time in order to stay on track for the next learner.

Payment Policy

Clients will be invoiced on the last day of each month for all sessions that took place during that month. **Payment is due within 10 days, by the 10th of the following month.** Invoices can be paid by check, Venmo, or credit card.

If you plan to use an Educational Freedom Account (EFA) through ClassWallet, please let me know in advance so we can make the necessary arrangements.

Payments not received by the **15th of the month** may be subject to a \$15 late fee. If a balance remains unpaid for more than 30 days, services may be paused until payment is received.

Cancellation Policy



Life happens — and so do colds, stomach bugs, and unexpected hiccups in the schedule. If your child is sick, please keep them home to rest and recover. I appreciate your help in keeping everyone healthy.

Each student is allowed 2 free cancellations per academic semester (Fall and Spring). After the third missed session, any additional absences will be billed at the full session rate, regardless of the reason.

If cancellations become frequent or ongoing, we may need to reevaluate services, as consistency is key to making progress.

That said, I understand that things come up! Please reach out as soon as possible if you need to cancel. I'll always do my best to be flexible and understanding.

Any session I need to cancel will, of course, not be charged, and I'll communicate with you as early as I can.

Weather Related Closings

If the weather gets rough, safety comes first. Ozark Dyslexia Services will follow **Gravette** and **Bentonville Public Schools** for weather-related closures. If **either** district cancels school or dismisses early due to inclement weather, our sessions will also be canceled for the day.

I'll do my best to reschedule any missed sessions due to weather when possible. If a make-up session can't be arranged, you won't be charged for the missed time. I'll keep in touch and communicate any changes as early as I can. If you're ever unsure, feel free to reach out — I'm happy to confirm the day's plans!

Assessments and Progress Reports

Every student begins with an initial assessment. From there, I use informal checks during sessions to guide instruction and track progress in real time. In addition, I use formal progress monitoring assessments at the middle and end of the academic year. You'll receive a written progress report at those times so you can see how your child is growing.

I'm always happy to talk about your child's progress at any time. If you need written documentation for your child's school, please let me know with plenty of notice so I can prepare the necessary documents.
