Too many of America's Vets fight on an invisible battlefield. Every day, 20+ Vets die by suicide, often as the result of PTSD and related mental health issues. This is a glaring failure to those who have sacrificed so much. We can help save lives with a proven success tool: Service Dogs.

Founded in 2014, Team Foster provides a crucial lifeline to injured and disabled Veterans at no cost to them by funding highly trained and accredited service dogs, and offering lifetime support to Veteran–service dog teams. Team Foster has raised over \$2,000,000 to date through community events like Ruff Ride Pittsburgh.

There are limited resources to connect Vets with properly trained service dogs. Team Foster bridges that gap through events like Ruff Ride. Show up for the Veteran community at Team Foster's Ruff Ride Pittsburgh event. This 24-hour spin event starts at 10:00 am on September 27th at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. Part competition and part festival, you can ride for 15 minutes or 5 hours.


