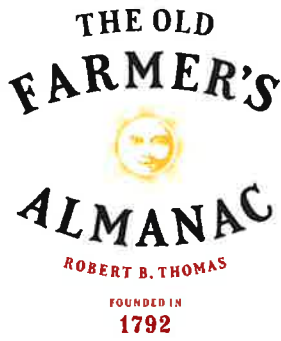

A total solar eclipse happens when the moon passes between the sun and Earth. This blocks all rays of sunlight emitting from the sun and the sky goes dark.

“Farm animals go into their barns and birds go home to roost and things get cold. You don’t think about it, but the sun goes away and things get cold, it gets dark, and it’s a little eerie,” Grand Rapids Public Museum

Planetarium Manager Jack Daleske said. Depending on where you are in the United States, totality can last anywhere from 2.5 minutes to just over four minutes. “It’s possible because of the size of the moon and sun and the distance. Of course, the sun is much, much bigger than the moon and it’s 400 times farther away. By coincidence, that means they are exactly or almost exactly the apparent same size,” Daleske said.

In West Michigan, a 90% partial eclipse will be seen. This means that the sky will not go completely dark. A crescent shape sun will be seen during the duration. The last total solar eclipse in the United States was in 2017. After the one in April, the next one will be in the south in 2045. The next total solar eclipse in Michigan will not be until 2099.

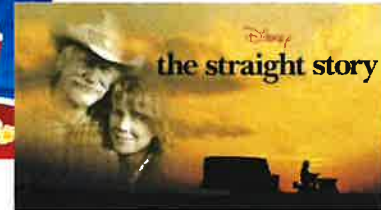
