- ★ We try to keep the building and each room, between 72 – 74 degrees. If you are still too hot, or cold, let someone know. Something to remember is we do not run on forced air furnace heat; we have in floor radiant heat, so adjusting the thermostat is not a quick fix.
- ★ Per building codes, extension cords are not allowed in rooms, but surge protectors are.
- ★ You are allowed to have a space heater but must have prior approval from administration.
- ★ You may own a heated blanket if it has an automatic shut off per our fire code. Which means nothing made before 1960.
- ★ Humidifiers are very helpful during these winter months. Humidifiers add moisture to the air. They can help people with dry skin, allergies, and respiratory problems. They may also help prevent influenza.
- ★ Make sure your loved ones have appropriate clothing for the winter season.

- ★ We provide one set of twin sheets, one blanket, one comforter, and one pillow. If you bring in special items, please make sure they are marked clearly.
- ★ All food items in their rooms must be in a sealable plastic container, clearly dated, and may not be kept on the floor.
- ★ Per state regulations, no "to go" containers or leftover containers are allowed in the kitchen. Only items in unopened store-bought containers, with a clear expiration date, are allowed.
- ★ If you join a loved one for a holiday meal, be aware that your cost is paid only in cash.
- ★ It is just as important to know if someone is leaving for the holidays. Staff knowing can help remind them and get them ready before you arrive. Kitchen knowing will help with seating and having the correct amount of food is prepared.
- ★ Any item brought to the kitchen will be disposed of when they reach their expiration date.
