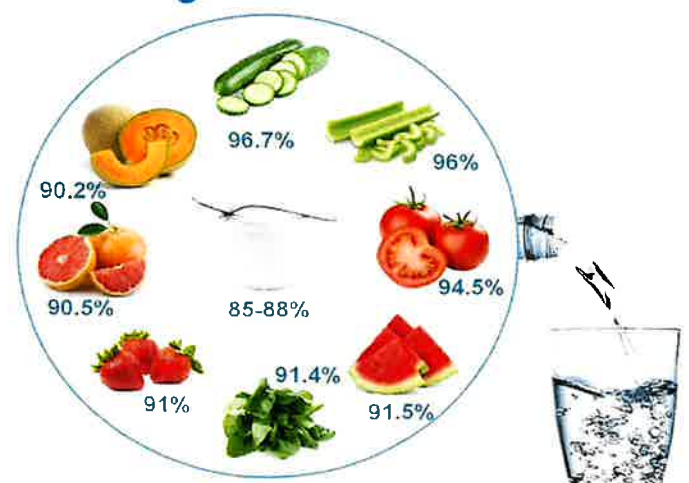
Just a
