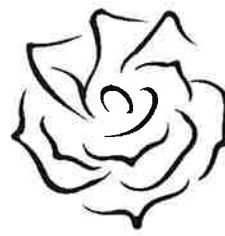

The autumnal equinox arrives on Monday, September 22.

Not only do temperatures drop, but plant life slows down, and so do we. After the autumnal equinox, days become shorter than nights as the Sun continues to rise later and nightfall arrives earlier. This ends with the winter solstice, after which days start to grow longer once again. The word “equinox” comes from Latin *aequus*, meaning “equal,” and *nox*, “night.” On the equinox, day and night are roughly equal.

- 🍂 Once the goldenrod is in full bloom, it's 6 weeks until frost.
- 🍂 The brighter the leaf colors in fall, the colder and snowier the winter will be.
- 🍂 The earlier fall color peaks, the milder the winter will be.
- 🍂 When plants that usually bloom in spring have a second bloom in fall, expect a cold winter.
