

 - *Customers must have a registered Kroger rewards card account to link to our church.
- * If you do not have a Kroger rewards card, they are available at the customer service desk at any Kroger.
- * You must swipe your registered Kroger rewards card or use the phone number that is related to your registered Kroger rewards card for each purchase to count.

Hosparus Health Southern Indiana invites compassionate individuals to join its team of volunteers to support patients and families across Clark, Crawford, Floyd, Harrison, Jefferson, Orange, Scott, and Washington counties. The nonprofit hospice and palliative care organization is hosting a free, in-person training session for new volunteers on Tuesday, September 23, 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at 502 Hausfeldt Lane in New Albany.

Volunteer responsibilities include offering companionship to patients, providing respite for caregivers, supporting grief services or veteran initiatives, and even sharing a love of reading, music, or crafting. Additionally, volunteers can contribute to the organization behind the scenes with administrative assistance, writing letters and cards, making deliveries, and serving on committees.

Interested individuals should apply at hosparushealth.org/volunteers before the training session. If you are unable to attend in September, you can still apply now and register for future training opportunities. The **next training opportunity will be held on November 13**, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at our New Albany office. All volunteers must meet certain health requirements before starting.
