**Introduction:** Highly pathogenic avian influenza is a fatal and contagious disease of poultry and has led to the loss of more than 100 million birds in the United States since 2022. The virus causing this disease can be spread by infected wild and domestic birds, on products such as feathers and eggs, on clothing, vehicles, equipment, and other fomites such as packing materials, and through the air. However, if all protocols for reducing the risk of spreading disease are followed, market birds, non-poultry, hatchlings, and avian products, including unfertilized and fertilized eggs and ornamental feathers may be exhibited or displayed, in accordance with the standards established under the Department’s *General Quarantine Order; 2025 Exhibition of Market Birds, Non-Poultry, Hatchlings, Feathers, and Eggs*.

A completed *Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement* must accompany market birds, non-poultry, hatchlings, and avian products, including unfertilized and fertilized eggs and ornamental feathers, to a Pennsylvania Venue or Fair within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania which is sponsored by or receives funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture pursuant to the Pennsylvania Agricultural Fair Act (act of July 8, 1986, P.L. 437, No. 92)(3 P.S. §§ 1501- 1510). The certificate must be presented to exhibition management prior to cooping of market birds and non-poultry, or display of hatchlings and avian products, including unfertilized and fertilized eggs and ornamental feathers. The form must be endorsed with the signature of the owner of the market birds, non-poultry, hatchlings, and avian products, including unfertilized and fertilized eggs and ornamental feathers.

**3. Verification of Biosecurity:** Biosecurity measures for all market birds, non-poultry, hatchlings, and avian products, including unfertilized and fertilized eggs and ornamental feathers being exhibited or displayed include a biosecurity plan which is followed on the premises where the source flock is located, to include at minimum:

- a. Visitors to bird housing areas are restricted.
- b. Anyone visiting the bird housing area should have clean clothing and should have used hand sanitizer or washed their hands before handling birds, feathers, eggs, or related equipment.
- c. Designated footwear or footwear that has been cleaned and disinfected is worn in the bird housing area by anyone entering the area. A clear line of separation exists at the entrance to the bird housing area.
- d. All ornamental feathers and unfertilized and fertilized eggs for exhibition are maintained in a biosecure manner, separate from birds and other avian products, prior to entry into the exhibition.
- e. All conveyances, including transport vehicles, coops, crates, boxes, and other containers used to transport market birds, non-poultry, hatchlings, and avian products, including unfertilized and fertilized eggs and ornamental feathers to an exhibition are cleaned to be free of visible manure, litter, or other debris.
- f. All coops, crates, boxes, and other containers used to transport market birds, non-poultry, hatchlings, and avian products, including unfertilized and fertilized eggs and ornamental feathers to an exhibition shall be disinfected with a product effective against the avian influenza virus and allowed to dry before use.
- g. All exhibitors should follow the current biosecurity guidelines: *Keeping Your Show Animals Healthy-Guidelines for Exhibitors*.

SIZE - Total weight of exhibit C.: A perfect score will be given to the dozen of eggs weighing between 24 and 27 ounces. If the average weight is within one ounce, either above 27 or below 24 ounces, cut 8 points. If more than one ounce, either above or below, cut 16 points.

UNIFORMITY OF COLOR - All eggs in the entry should be the same shade of color. If white, all eggs should be chalked white and free from creamy or tinted coloring. If brown, eggs should be uniformly the same shade of color. A cut of 1/4 to 1/2 point per egg may be made according to actual shade of each egg and how well it conforms to uniformity of shade with the other eggs in the dozen.

UNIFORMITY OF SHAPE - Each egg to conform as nearly as possible in shape. Extremes should be avoided. Cut 1/4 to 1/2 point for each egg off in shape or ridged.

SHELL TEXTURE - The shell should be strong and of uniform thickness. Cut 1/4 to 1/2 point per egg for shells that are rough, ridged or wrinkled and for shells that are porous, mottled or blind check. Cut one point for each egg that is cracked or a leaker.

CONDITION - The egg should be clean and carry a natural bloom. Cut 1/2 to one point for each dirty or stained egg or egg with shiny or glassy surface.

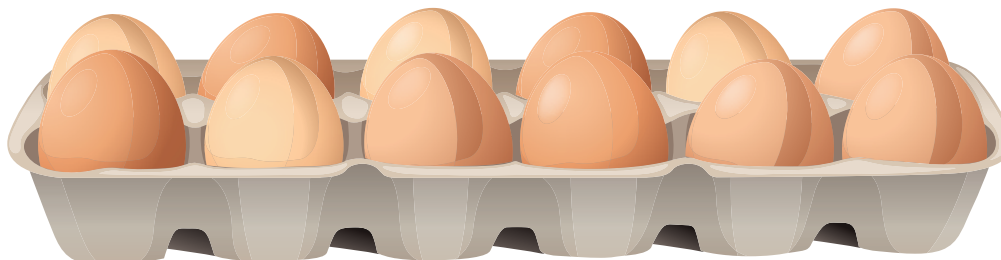

2. Decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at shows shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges. This includes sale advertising!
3. Rabbits considered for entry, must meet the PA. Dept of Health specifications listed on page 6 of this premium book.
4. All rabbits are to be judged according to the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
5. All rabbits must have a permanent ear mark.
6. There will be senior, intermediate, and junior classes in all breeds maturing at 9 pounds and over.
7. Rabbits exhibits must be removed by 9:00 A.M. Sunday, August 30
8. All exhibits remaining after 11:00 A.M. Sunday, August 30 will become the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.
9. Any exhibitor not satisfied with feed and water facilities provided by the fair may bring their own equipment, properly identified.
10. The fair management reserves the right to limit the number of entries per exhibitor because of the size of the facilities.
11. Meat pens may be entered. They must consist of 3 rabbits, 59 days old or under; weight not over 5 lbs. – each rabbit. All the same breed and variety.
12. Exhibitors are encouraged to handle their own entries on the day of judging. The department will provide a limited number of personnel to carry the entries for judging.
