- 1. Exhibitors will be expected to accept the stall assigned without controversy, and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.
2. Decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at shows shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges. This includes sale advertising!
3. Cattle considered for entry, must meet the PA. Dept of Health specifications listed on page 4 of this premium book.
4. All Beef Cattle shown in weight classes will be weighed beginning at 5pm on Sunday.

Animal Health Regulations

IMPORTANT: ALL HEALTH PAPERS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. Cattle for exhibition require a CVI valid 30 days after date of issue, Ear Tagging compliance, and a current rabies vaccination (market animals exempt).
