- * In selecting vegetables for exhibition, choose such specimens that would bring the highest market price. Do not select the largest, select medium size specimens.
- * The following are factors considered by judges:
 - * Trueness to variety type. If at all possible, pick the specimen from one variety.
 - * Uniformity in shape, size and color.
 - * Be sure to pick out a perfect specimen, then select the others as similar to it as possible.
 - * Never mix specimens of different maturity.
 - * Protect from dirt, disease, infection, and mechanical damage.
 - * Select specimens that are perfect and show no blemishes of any kind.
 - * Condition and maturity. Be sure exhibits are of high quality.
 - * Potatoes should not be washed. Remove all soil using a soft cloth or brush.
 - * Tomatoes should have stems removed. Carrots, beets, etc. should have tops removed from vegetable leaving about two inches of stem.

*Read premium material carefully, following all rules and regulations. If any entry requires a specific number of specimens, be sure to exhibit the stated amount. Exhibits will be disqualified if the correct number is not entered.

- *Submitted in pint jar with lid.



Section 4
Live Herb Plants

Same herb types and entry numbers as listed in Section 2 - Fresh Green

- *Same herbs as listed under Fresh Green Herbs.
- *Containers not to exceed 10 inches.
- *Plants must be in exhibitors possession at least 2 months.
- *Container shall be leak-proof or supplied with saucer. NO DOUBLE POTTING.
- *Plants shall not display commercial labels.

Section 5
Herbal Vinegars

- *Judges will consider appearance, taste, and fragrance.
- *NO non-herbal additions.
- *Submitted in clear container of approximately one pint, with removable non-metallic lid.
- *Container DESIGN not judged.
- *Herbs must be shown in all vinegar.

- 025 - Tussie Mussie, Ribbon and lace permitted
- 030 - Wreath, using no plant material other than dried herbs. Bow permitted.
