SELECTION CRITERIA FOR MID-AMATEUR REPRESENTATIVE TEAM

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection criteria for the teams will be as follows:

Attitude and behaviour In the Team selection process, attitude and behaviour displayed by players and managers are of paramount importance. The only individuals who will be eligible for selection for any Ekurhuleni Golf Union team – irrespective of position on the order of merit - will be those who consistently display a respect for the etiquette of the game, as well as an attitude and behaviour that are of the highest standard. The reasons for this are simple. Once selected, these individuals will become role models for many other aspiring golfers; in addition, they will be representing the Union and all that it stands for and, finally, because attitude and behaviour are fundamental to the performance of both the individual and the team

EGU SELECTION COMMITTEE.

EGU President, Vice President, Second Vice President the Team Manager

A Team Manager will be appointed by the 3 (three) Executive Members as above, 10 (ten) months before the Inter Provincial. The Team Manager/s will monitor a group of players for possible selection, until a final squad of 12 (twelve) is formed. The final selection of the team will be 2 (two) months before the date of the tournament.

The team will consist of 8 (eight) players and a non-travelling reserve. The Team will be selected as follows:

1. 6 (six) players from the Ekurhuleni Golf Union Order of Merit (OoM) includes minimum 1 player of colour), 2 (two) Selector's choices and 1 (one) reserve.

Selectors choices are players from the Order of Merit who have lower positions on the log or may have failed to complete the number of qualifying tournaments. A player who has been selected as a Selectors choice on the bases of failing to complete the required number of tournaments may only be selected for 1 (one) Inter Provincial Tournament. A player moving from another Province may be selected as a Selectors choice after being a member of an EGU affiliated golf club for at least 6 (six) months.

All selections will be at the discretion of the selectors. A Selectors choice may also come from someone who only turns 30 years of age just before the start of the Inter Provincial.

EKURHULENI GOLF UNION ORDER OF MERIT MID-AMATEUR TOURNAMENTS FOR SELECTION - NUMBER OF TOURNAMENTS TO BE PLAYED FOR CONSIDERATION AT LEAST the 1 EGU compulsory tournament, 3 of the 5 Open Series, and at least 3 others = 7 minimum

Ekurhuleni Golf Union Open Mid-Amateur Championship (Regional tournament) - **Compulsory = 1000 POINTS** — any player (a member of an Ekurhuleni Golf Union affiliated golf club) who is unable to participate in this tournament must advise the Selectors in writing.

Ekurhuleni Golf Union Mid-AM Series (Local tournament) - Minimum of 3 (three) tournaments of 5 (five) required. = **300 points**

Provincial Mid-Amateur Open Championships (Regional Tournaments):

- 1. Ekurhuleni Open Strokeplay Championship = 1000 points
- 2. Ekurhuleni Golf Union Closed Championship = 500 points
- 3. Gauteng North Open Mid-Amateur Championship = 1000 points
- 4. Central Gauteng Open Mid-Amateur Championship = 1000 points
- 5. Highveld Open Mid-Amateur Championship = 1000 points
- 6. Lowveld Open Mid-Amateur Championship = 1000 points
- 7. North West Open Mid-Amateur Championship = 1000 points
- 8. Limpopo Open Mid-Amateur Championship = 1000 points
- 9. Border/EP Mid-Amateur Open = 1000 points
- 10. Northern Cape Mid-Amateur Open = **1000 points**
- 11. Southern Cape Mid-Amateur Open = **1000 points**
- 12. KZN Mid-Amateur Open- = 1000 points
- 13. Boland Mid-Amateur Open = 1000 points
- 14. SA Mid-Amateur Stroke Play = 1000 points

It is incumbent on interested players to ensure they play in as many tournaments as possible taking note of the aforementioned to give themselves the best possible chance for team selection.
